Re: District Response to SCTA Proposed Distance Learning Schedules

Dear Mr. Fisher:

In preparation for our negotiations on distance learning scheduled for Monday, August 24, 2020, we will share with you by noon tomorrow the District's response to the proposed schedules that you shared with us during negotiations on August 13, 2020. Our team looks forward to reviewing the District's proposed schedules and responding to any questions that you have on August 24th and send these with the hope that the meeting is not entirely spent on reviewing the District's proposed schedules and instead try to finalize our agreement so that our community can prepare for the start of our school year on September 3, 2020. We also look forward to receiving SCTA's response to the District's August 13, 2020 proposal on distance learning as well as the District's proposal on health and safety.

Should a final agreement not be reached on August 24th, the District proposes to schedule additional dates for negotiations with SCTA on August 25 and 26, 2020, so that this important work can continue. Our students, families and community are anxiously awaiting information on what the reopening of schools will look like on September 3, 2020. Completing negotiations on the effects of distance learning and moving forward with a robust distance learning program is the District's top priority. We hope that SCTA will join us in committing to complete this work as soon as possible to provide information and certainty to our students, families and community as they prepare to return to learn in these very challenging and uncertain times.
