This letter follows the negotiations session between the District and the Sacramento City Teachers Association (SCTA) on July 2, 2020 to discuss the negotiable effects of reopening our schools on September 3, 2020. At that session, the District's negotiations team presented SCTA with a proposal on the health and safety aspects of reopening our schools and responded to the questions and comments from SCTA's Executive Director, John Borsos, related to the District's proposal. SCTA also shared its "talking points" document, which appears to list the effects of reopening our schools that SCTA believes to be negotiable. The District's team also discussed, but has not received a counter from SCTA on, the District's proposal on our early start schools—New Joseph Bonnheim and New Tech, and child development programs—Edward Kemble and Hiram Johnson.
