A12-00044.1 City of Sacramento Police Department	2/1/12 – 12/31/12: Supplemental Agreement extending term of original agreement and increasing funding to pay for one full time Gang Violence Prevention/Intervention Specialist. Duties include gang awareness training, prevention, intervention and suppression. The Gang Violence Prevention/Intervention Specialists will coordinate with subcontractors, law enforcement, school administration, staff and parents to provide direct services to program participants. The district will continue to assist with truancy and curfew sweeps in the target area of the grant (Hiram Johnson, Luther Burbank and C.K. McClatchy High Schools). In addition to the above duties, the Gang Violence Prevention/Intervention Specialist works with students and families to provide alternatives to gang involvement.  Strategic Plan: Aligns with Pillar II, Family and Community Engagement, by continuing a strategic partnership that provides resources, mentoring, training, and counseling to at-risk students and their families.
