Hello, my name is Pablo Lopez. I have a son and daughter that attend Rosa Parks Elementary School. We moved here from San Jose, CA. I have to say this is the worst school system I've ever dealt with. My daughter is now in the 5th grade and thank god she is smart and has wonderful teachers (teachers in your district are NOT the problem. They're great). The problem is there's no money. Where is the money? Harmony has NEVER been on a field trip as long as she has been at Rosa Parks. I was told by my sons Occupational Therapist teacher there is ONE Maintenance man for the whole district. That is simply ridiculous. My son cannot even get full Time Special Education from your district because there is apparently no classes for Pre-K Autistic kids. The misappropriation of the funds in this district is evident. And if your response is the funds are not being misappropriated, then I'm willing to call you liars. When we speak to people about getting my son the maximum assistance available we are met with people that just shrug their shoulders at our discontent because they have no options and are completely broken down because everything about this district seems non functional. How is this even acceptable? How is everybody from the top down this incompetent and corrupt? Luckily my wife and I are vocal parents who advocate for our children. This fact seems to bother those who work for your district as I'm sure they are constantly hearing how you guys are doing our children a disservice. My wife broke down in tears during a IEP meeting today because there is NO placement for our son. He gets one hour of therapy per week and we're told there's nothing we can do until by I guess some miracle of god something opens up. We have been going through this with your district for an ENTIRE year. When we emailed the district last May of '22, we didn't hear back from anybody for practically 4 months. We finally got him started this year in April. We also have a MOU set up to try and get him back-dated therapy. Geovani Linares has just barely set that up for us. We've had numerous meetings with him and Jill Weber and their responses seem apathetic at best. How can you people even call yourselves educators when no one is advocating for these children? Rosa Parks has had so many different principals since my daughter started attending I've stopped keeping track. NONE of the Principals seem like

they even give a damn about these kids. The whole situation is disgusting. I'm going to start emailing your whole district, councilmen, City and State representatives. Because obviously this will more than likely fall on def ears. If you have any real concern for this someone will respond. If not you will hear from me one way or another.
