Open enrollment fair/showcase of schools helps determine which school best fit for students for the 2010-11 academic year

For parents wondering about options for their children in the 2010-11 school year, the Sacramento City Unified School District “Open Enrollment Fair/Showcase of Schools” is the place to go for information about programs and meeting principals, fellow students and teachers from all schools in the district. Families will also be able to learn more about the January 2010 open enrollment application process which allows students to apply to schools not in their neighborhood attendance area. Representatives from local colleges will also be available.

Sac City Unified’s fair and showcase of schools is scheduled for Saturday, Nov. 7 from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. at the SCUSD’s Serna Center, 5735 47th Ave.

The free event is open to families residing in or out of the district. Families living outside district boundaries can attend SCUSD campuses by applying for an inter-district permit (and based on space availability).

“This is a great opportunity to highlight all our schools in one place and the many options our district offers to families,” said Superintendent Jonathan P. Raymond. “Many of our university and college partners will also be present and can help students and parents with information about the college application process,” Raymond added.

Visitors to the fair will be able to browse school and district web sites and pick up brochures and other information about schools and programs.
