<u>Division</u> : Superintendent's Office
Recommendation : Receive feedback on current resources and future direction on the development of a Safe Haven School District.
Background/Rationale: Some vulnerable students and families within district boundaries became deeply concerned with the outcome of the 2016 presidential election results. In turn, this elevated the district's concern for our students' socio-emotional learning and academic achievement. The Board of Education passed the Safe Haven School District Resolution, which prompted a call for staff to develop a visible resource for students and families and provide an opportunity for interested community members to participate in a call to action.
Staff has since created an informational flier outlining the resolution, has begun engaging stakeholder groups in gathering input and feedback, and has started developing an online portal of resources for the SCUSD community. This item is before the Board of Education to outline current staff progress and ongoing plans for community engagement, and to continue soliciting input and feedback.
