# Transition Plan

## Short Term Goals

- Finalize student placements
- Engage district, community, and site
- Develop timelines
- Identify procedures for redistribution of materials and equipment
- Clear and consistent communication

## Mid Term Goals

- Continued stakeholder participation
- Clear direction to staff on responsibilities and key tasks
- Appropriate movement of materials and equipment
- Clear and consistent communication

## Long Term Goals

- Facilitate the transfer of students in a respectful and sensitive manner
- Ensure sites and classrooms are prepared to receive new students
- Engage community participation to ensure smooth transition process
- Clear and consistent communication



## Phase 1 - Student Placement

### Students assigned to new sites by residence

#### **Open Enrollment Lottery** – April 23, 2013 – 99% placement

- 464 students placed in 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> choice
- 3 students on 1<sup>st</sup> choice waiting list
- 2 students did not meet criteria for school of choice

#### **Registration** - May 13, 2013 – May 24, 2013

- On site registration at current school
- Extended outreach, if necessary



## Phase 1 - Student Placement

### Registration Results:

- 80% students registered for (confirmed) open enrollment placements
- 20% did not register, declined, or have selected intra process
- Extended outreach to families who did not register

### Next Steps:

- Review intradistrict permit requests in August
- Approve intradistrict permits as space and capacity allows
- Review enrollments/Adjust staff as necessary - Sept.



## Phase 2 - Planning

### Staffing

May 16, 2013 - 1st option surplus for closing site teachers

- 78 teachers eligible
- 20 teachers placed

May 20 – 23, June 5, 2013 – 2<sup>nd</sup> option surplus

- 44 teachers placed
- 14 teachers waiting placement





## Phase 2 - Planning

### Transportation Plan

- Develop tentative routes and stops for C.P. Huntington, Fruit Ridge, Joseph Bonnheim, Maple, and Washington
- Coordinate routes and stops to accommodate school start and end times
- Thirty minutes built into schedule for breakfast program
- Color coded maps and corresponding routes for ease of use
- Information provided to site for distribution to families prior to June 13, 2013

## Phase 2 - Planning

### Transportation Plan

#### Next Steps:

- Coordinate special education routes - August
- Coordinate NCLB and concapping - September
- Provide online access to all ridership information on Transportation website
- Ongoing communication during summer with Family Resource Center support
- Begin transportation services on September 3, 2013
- Monitor and adjust routes based upon actual ridership



## Phase 2 - Planning

### After School Programs

- Data collection and focus groups
- Develop fair, equitable process for all families affected by schools closing
- Information clinics held at closing and receiving sites
- Mark Hopkins/Rosa Parks
- Information also disseminated through flyers, ConnectEd messaging, and personal contact
- Applications for lottery accepted May 13- 17



## Phase 2 - Planning

### After School Program Continue

- Lottery process
- Parents notified of lottery results
- 81% families received placement
- After School Resource List provided to wait listed families
- Continue to identify funding

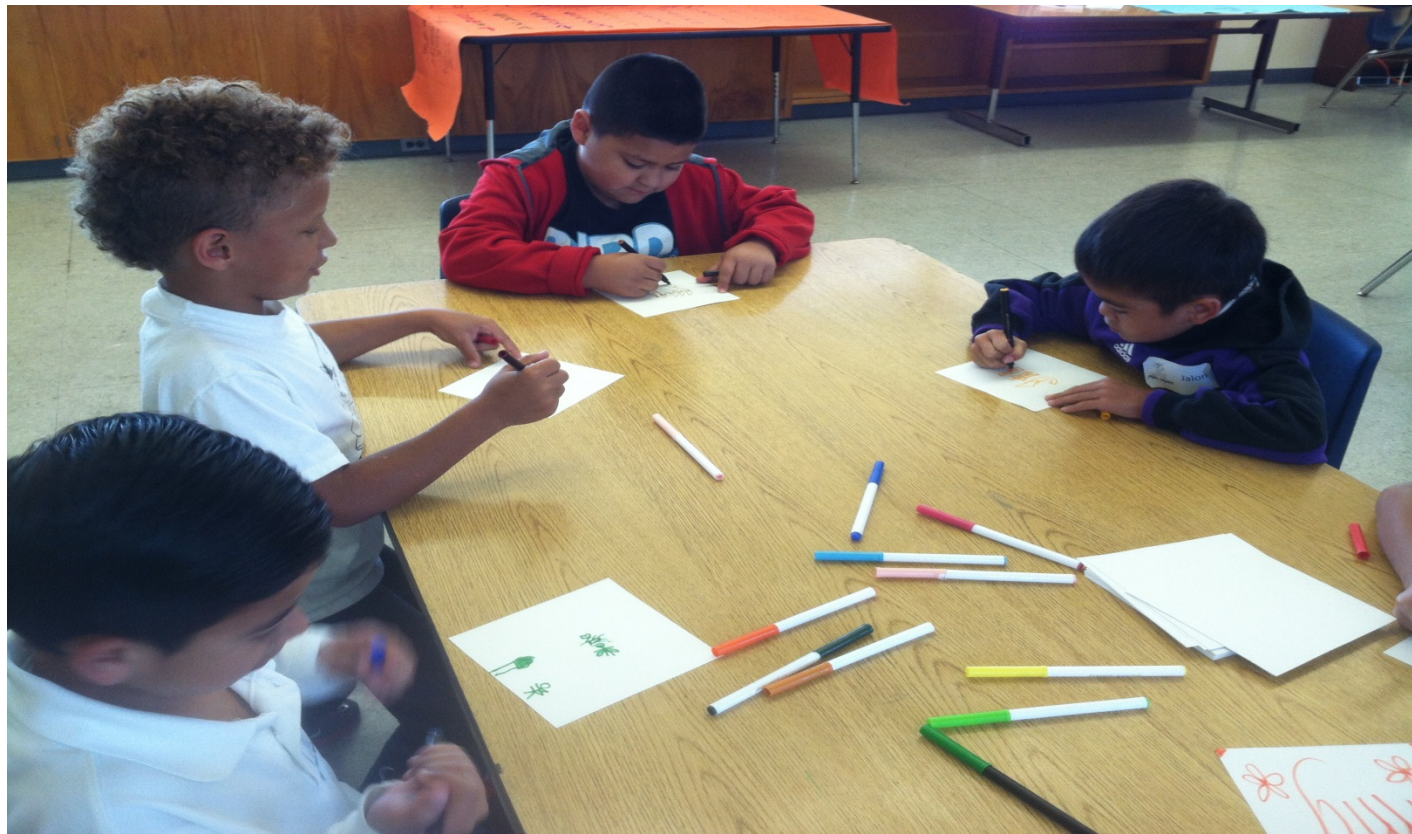
