 - a. State Resolution Codes: 100, 110, 300 or 200
- 4. The date of the incident must be during the current Reporting Year (July 1 to the following June 30).
- 5. The Resolution must be <u>at least one day in duration</u> by the <u>Resolution Start and End Dates and</u> <u>the School Days Duration.</u>
- 6. Behavior Referrals must be in Complete status

The following students do not report:

- Student not marked as Offender.
- Students who do not have a State ID.
- Students who have Behavior Referrals that is in draft status or In-Progress Behavior Incidents.
- Students marked as state exclude, in grade levels marked as state exclude or in calendars marked as state exclude.
