Application and Selection Process: We encourage all 10th grade students to apply.

- In order to apply, we need 3 items by March 31, 2018 (feel free to email them to us):
 - 1. A completed application (available on our website: www.buckscholars.org/apply)
 - 2. A copy of your transcripts
 - 3. **TWO** completed Fellows Program recommendation forms (available on our website <u>www.buckscholars.org/apply</u>)
- Finalists will be interviewed on a date in late April 2018.
- 2018 Buck Fellows will be selected and announced by mid-May to early June 2018.
