Dear Parent or Guardian,

As you may be aware, the state of California requires all incoming 7th graders to show proof of Tdap and 2 Varicella vaccines (or valid medical exemption) prior to attending 7th grade. We have enclosed detailed information regarding Tdap and Varicella, as well as answers to frequently asked questions.

In order for your child to start 7th grade, you will need to do one of the following before school begins:

- A. Provide documentation showing that your child has all immunizations required.
- B. Submit a medical exemption for missing shot(s) and immunization records for all required shots not exempted. See https://www.shotsforschool.org/laws/exemptions/ for more information.

What is a medical exemption?

A medical exemption is a signed, written statement from a physician (M.D. or D.O.) licensed in California which states:

- 1. The specific nature of the physical condition or medical circumstances of the child for which a licensed physician does not recommend immunization.
- 2. Each specific required vaccines that is being exempted.
- 3. If the medical exemption is permanent or temporary.
- 4. If the exemption is temporary, an expiration date no more than 12 calendar months from the date of signing.

If your student has not yet received these immunizations, please contact your child's medical provider right away.

- If you do not have a medical provider, we have enclosed a list of Sacramento Area Community Immunization Clinics. (www.scusd.edu/post/sacramento-area-community-immunization-clinics)
- If you do not have health insurance, you can get assistance with signing up for health insurance from Sacramento Covered at (866) 850-4321 or http://sacramentocovered.org/enroll.

This is also a good time to discuss any other immunization needs. Although Tdap and 2 Varicella are required for school entry, it is recommended that your child also obtain Meningococcal and HPV vaccines in this age group. If you have any questions, please contact the Sacramento County Public Health Immunization Branch at (916) 875-7468 or SCUSD Health Services at (916) 643-9412.

Students entering 7^{th} grade who do not meet the immunization requirements <u>will not be able to attend school</u>. Please bring a copy of your child's immunization record(s) or valid medical exemption to our front office before school begins.

Thank you for helping us keep your child, our school, and our community safe and healthy.

PARENTS' GUIDE TO IMMUNIZATIONS

REQUIRED FOR SCHOOL ENTRY



Starting July 1, 2019

Students Admitted at TK/K-12 Need:

Diphtheria, Tetanus, and Pertussis (DTaP, DTP, Tdap, or Td) — 5 doses

(4 doses OK if one was given on or after 4th birthday.
3 doses OK if one was given on or after 7th birthday.)
For 7th-12th graders, at least 1 dose of pertussis-containing vaccine is required on or after 7th birthday.

Polio (OPV or IPV) — 4 doses

(3 doses OK if one was given on or after 4th birthday)

Hepatitis B — 3 doses

(Not required for 7th grade entry)

Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (MMR) — 2 doses

(Both given on or after 1st birthday)

Varicella (Chickenpox) — 2 doses

These immunization requirements apply to new admissions and transfers for all grades, including transitional kindergarten.

Students Starting 7th Grade Need:

Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis (Tdap) —1 dose

(Whooping cough booster usually given at 11 years and up)

Varicella (Chickenpox) — 2 doses

(Usually given at ages 12 months and 4-6 years)

In addition, the TK/K-12 immunization requirements apply to 7th graders who:

- previously had a valid personal beliefs exemption filed before 2016 upon entry between TK/Kindergarten and 6th grade
- are new admissions

Records:

California schools are required to check immunization records for all new student admissions at TK/Kindergarten through 12th grade and all students advancing to 7th grade before entry. Parents must show their child's Immunization Record as proof of immunization.



Vaccine Requirements for 7th Grade Students

Tdap (Pertussis/Whooping Cough)

What Parents Need To Know

What is the pertussis booster requirement?

<u>All students entering, advancing or transferring into 7th grade will need proof of an adolescent whooping cough booster immunization (called "Tdap"), or medical exemption, prior to attending school in the fall.</u>

What if my child does not have proof of a Tdap shot before school starts?

Your child will not be able to start school until you submit the documentation for the Tdap requirement to the school.

Is there a grace period/extension to get the shot AFTER school starts?

No. Under current law, schools do not have the option to provide a grace period. All $7^{\rm th}$ grade students will need to show proof of Tdap immunization or submit a medical exemption before starting school in September.

What is Tdap and what are the diseases that the Tdap vaccine prevents?

Tdap is a booster vaccine for older children, adolescents, and adults. It safely protects against 3 dangerous diseases: tetanus, diphtheria, and whooping cough (also called pertussis).

- **Pertussis** also known as whooping cough, is a contagious disease that causes violent coughing fits that make it hard to breathe. It spreads easily when someone with the disease coughs or sneezes. The symptoms can last for months. Whooping cough is particularly dangerous for young babies.
- **Tetanus** causes a severe, painful tightening (spasms) of muscles, including of the jaw ("lockjaw") which can limit swallowing and breathing.
- **Diphtheria** is a throat infection that can lead to breathing problems, paralysis, heart failure and death.

Do ALL 7th grade students need to get the pertussis immunization?

Yes. Unless they have a medical exemption, all students going into 7th grade must have proof of having had the Tdap booster shot, or a medical exemption. This includes current students, new students and transfer students in both public and private schools.

Many students have already received the vaccine and simply need to supply proof to the school, so check with your doctor or provider.

Why is the Tdap vaccine required?

This new requirement will help protect your child and others in your school and community from whooping cough. Whooping cough is a serious disease that causes coughing fits that can last for months. In recent years, whooping cough has been increasing in the United States. Whooping cough has been widespread in California and was responsible for 10 infant deaths in 2010.

When should my child get vaccinated with Tdap?

Now. Unimmunized children are at risk for catching pertussis, getting really sick and missing weeks of school. Besides protecting your child, you can also beat the back-to-school rush by making an appointment for your incoming 7^{th} grader to get a Tdap booster shot now.

- Keep documentation of your child's Tdap booster shot in a safe place.
- Provide a copy to your child's current school now.



Vaccine Requirements for 7th Grade Students

Varicella (Chickenpox)

What Parents Need To Know

What is the Varicella (Chickenpox) immunization requirement?

<u>All students entering, advancing or transferring into 7th grade</u> will need proof of having had a 2^{nd} Varicella (Chickenpox) immunization or medical exemption, prior to attending school in the fall.

What if my child does not have proof of a second Varicella (Chickenpox) shot before school starts?

Your child will not be able to start school until you submit the documentation for the second Varicella (Chickenpox) requirement to the school.

Is there a grace period/extension to get the shot AFTER school starts?

No. Under current law, schools do not have the option to provide a grace period. All 7th grade students will need to show proof of a second Varicella (Chickenpox) immunization or submit a medical exemption before starting school in August.

What is Varicella (Chickenpox)?

Chickenpox is a disease that causes an itchy rash of blisters and a fever. A person with Chickenpox may have as many as 500 blisters. The rash can spread over the whole body. Chickenpox can be serious, even life-threatening, especially in babies, adolescents, adults, pregnant women and people with weakened immune systems.

Do ALL 7th grade students need to get a second Varicella (Chickenpox) immunization?

Yes. Unless they have a medical exemption, all students going into 7th grade must have proof of having had a second Varicella (Chickenpox) immunization. This includes current students, new students, and transfer students in both public and private schools. Many students have already received a second Varicella (Chickenpox) immunization and simply need to supply proof to the school, so check with your doctor or provider.

Why is a second Varicella (Chickenpox) immunization required?

Two doses of the Varicella (Chickenpox) vaccine are about 90% effective at preventing Chickenpox. When your student gets vaccinated, your student protects him-or herself and others in your household and community. This is especially important for people who cannot get vaccinated, such as those with weakened immune systems or pregnant women.

When should my child get vaccinated for Varicella (Chickenpox)?

Now. Unimmunized children are at risk for getting Chickenpox. Chickenpox spreads easily, mainly when a person touches or breathes in the virus particles that come from Chickenpox blisters. It can also spread through tiny droplets that get into the air when someone who has Chickenpox breathes or talks, for example. Chickenpox is contagious beginning 1 to 2 days before the rash appears and remains contagious until all the blisters have scabbed over. Besides protecting your child, you can also beat the back-to-school rush by making an appointment for your incoming 7th grader to get a Varicella (Chickenpox) shot now. Please remember to:

- Keep documentation of your child's immunizations in a safe place.
- Provide a copy to your child's current school <u>now</u>.
