## **YOUTH AIDE**

### Job Announcement - Spring 2018

The Landscape and Learning program is an employment program operated by the City of Sacramento, Department of Parks and Recreation for young people between 14 and 17 years of age. Youth will be hired to **work six hours per day, Saturdays and Sundays**. Youth Aides work in groups, including an adult supervisor, providing park maintenance in city parks. Typical duties include general weeding, trimming and restroom cleaning. **Youth Aides are required to wear boots.** Hiking boots are acceptable.

<u>Print clearly using black or blue ink</u>. If any portion of your application is incomplete or not readable your application will not be considered for employment.

SALARY: \$11.00 per hour

HOURS: Saturdays and Sundays; 6 ½ hours per day (including a ½ hour unpaid lunch)

AGE: Applicants must be 14 to 17 years old on March 1, 2018.

RESIDENCE: **Applicants MUST reside within the city limits of the City of Sacramento.** <u>Please note: not all</u> Sacramento address are within the city of Sacramento city limits.

CITIZENSHIP: Applicants must be able to submit right to work documents that establish both identity and employment authorization. The most common acceptable documents are a photo identification card and signed social security card. **Documents are due at the time of employment (please do not submit with this application packet).**
