Philosophy, Goals, Objectives and Comprehensive Plans

With a strong belief that all children and others within our community and society can be successful learners, given the shared vision and commitment of the entire school community, and that the most effective decisions are made when those most closely affected play a significant role in the making of those decisions, the Board of Education of Sacramento City Unified School District authorizes the implementation and maintenance of a plan for site-based decision-making that involves all sites, subject to the provisions of agreements with employee unions and the District Steering Committee for site-based decision-making. The Governing Board will support the training of individuals involved in the site-based decision-making.
