# **GLAZIER FOREMAN**

## **DEFINITION**

Under general direction, to perform skilled glazier work and to supervise glaziers at the journeyman-level engaged in installing and replacing glass in school buildings.

## **EXAMPLES OF DUTIES**

Assigns subordinates to work details and checks work in progress and upon completion to ensure that it meets required standards; inspects buildings and windows reported to be in need of repair and considers the need for repair, estimates the time, labor, and materials needed; supervises and performs the cutting and installation of plate glass for desk and table tops and showcases; replaces broken glass; applies putty, metal settings, or wood moldings to make glasswork secure and watertight; keeps records of time, glass used, and work performed and needed; keeps stockroom up to date and requisitions for stock; and performs related duties as required.

### **MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS**

# Knowledge of:

Standard methods, equipment, materials, and tools of the trade; Occupational hazards and safety precautions of the trade.

#### Ability to:

Effectively supervise skilled glaziers at the journeyman level;

Interpret complex oral and written instructions;

Perform skilled glazing work;

Make accurate estimates of time and materials needed for installation and repair work.

## Experience:

Three years of paid full-time experience as a journeyman glazier.

## **Education:**

Equivalent to completion of the tenth grade.
