1. I am interested in participating in your RFQ process. I have a question regarding your contract. I highlighted the Contract section below that pertains to my question. I do not know the scope of the project/s this RFQ relates to. How should I complete this section so I am in compliance with your RFQ?

ARTICLE 4: COMPENSATION

DISTRICT agrees to pay INSPECTOR for services rendered and accepted by DISTRICT at the rate of \$***Insert Data Here*** per hour, \$***Insert Data Here*** per overtime hour. If/When a contract is awarded, the SCUSD Contracts Office fills in all those blanks based on the project scope and IOR’s proposal.

Considering the geographical constraint of personally reviewing the document, I request you to provide us the following details before we buy the document:

- 1) List of Items, Schedule of Requirements, Scope of Work, Terms of Reference, Bill of Materials required.
- 2) Soft Copy of the Tender Document through email.
- 3) Names of countries that will be eligible to participate in this tender.
- 4) Information about the Tendering Procedure and Guidelines
- 5) Estimated Budget for this Purchase
- 6) Any Extension of Bidding Deadline?
- 7) Any Addendum or Pre Bid meeting Minutes?

Statements of Qualifications can only be considered from firms/individuals who live and work in the State of California, United States of America. You should be able to view the RFQ on our website, www.scusd.edu > Contracts > Request for Proposals. After reviewing the Scope of Services you can see why one must live here in order to provide the required services.

3. Question: Inspector of Record Agreement-- Article 1, Part L, Item q-- "Slump, Sampling and Transportation of Concrete" are listed as IOR tasks. This work is "Normally" performed by the Test Lab of Record. Does the District intend to assign these tasks to the Project Inspector on the DSA 103--Statement of Structural Tests and Special Inspections form?

No, however the IOR is responsible for verifying the slump number. Means and method is up to them.
