## **I. Overview of Middle Schools Data Report**

Sacramento City Unified School District currently operates eight middle schools: Albert Einstein, California, Fern Bacon, Kit Carson, Rosa Parks, Sutter and Will C. Wood. Middle school enrollment has decreased from 6,377 in 2007-08 to 5,618 in 2010-11. The percentage of middle school students living in poverty has increased over this period, from 67% to 75% and the percentage of Special Education middle school students has increased from 4% to 12% over four years.

This report provides an overview of middle school data on the following indicators: achievement on standardized test results; attendance; and suspensions over the four year period from 2007-08 to 2010-11. The California Standards Tests (CST) are designed to assess students' achievement of California's academic content standards in English Language Arts, mathematics, science and history/social science. California Modified Assessments (CMA) allow students who have an Individualized Education Plan (IEP) and are receiving grade level instruction and are not likely to achieve grade level proficiency within the year covered by the IEP to demonstrate their achievement of the content standards in core areas. These tests, along with the California Alternate Performance Assessment (CAPA), designed for students with significant cognitive disabilities, and the Standards-based Tests in Spanish (STS), designed for Spanish-speaking English Learners in U. S. schools for less than 12 months, form the basis of the California Standardized Testing and Reporting (STAR) program. Performance levels are used to measure student achievement. These are Advanced, Proficient, Basic, Below Basic and Far Below Basic. The expectation for meeting standards is that students achieve Proficient or Advanced levels.

## **II. Driving Governance:**

Pillar I (Career and College Ready Students) of the Districts Strategic Plan 2010-2014 demands that we continue to raise the achievement bar for all students in the district. "We will provide students with a relevant, rigorous and well-rounded education that includes 21st-century career exploration, visual and performing arts and that meets four-year college and university requirements. Our goal is for all schools to hold students to the highest academic expectations."

### III. Results:

In 2011, 50% of SCUSD middle school students scored proficient or advanced on Language Arts, 48% were proficient in Mathematics, 55% were proficient in Science and 45% scored proficient or advanced in Social Science. Since 2008, students made gains in ELA (6%), Mathematics (6%), Science (5%) and History/Social Science (10%). In ELA, the largest subgroup gains over four years were made by students with disabilities (21%) and Hispanic/Latino (8%), with three subgroups (American Indian, Two or More Races and Hawaiian/Pacific Islanders) declining in performance during that time period. In Mathematics, all subgroups except American Indian (-12%), Hawaiian/Pacific Islanders (-6%) and Two or More Races (-4%) increased in proficiency, with the largest gains posted by Students with Disabilities (12%), followed by White (11%), African American (8%) and Hispanic/Latino (8%). In Science, all subgroups except Two or More Races increased their proficiency, led by Filipinos (25%) and Students with Disabilities (22%). In History/Social Science, Hispanic/Latino students showed the largest increase (13%), followed by Socio-economically Disadvantaged (12%) and Filipino students at 10%. While the achievement gap narrowed for some subgroups (Hispanic/Latino, Students with Disabilities, Hmong, Cambodian and Socio-economically Disadvantaged), other subgroups (African-American, American Indian, Hawaiian/Pacific Islanders, and English Learners) saw the gap remain static or widen in some subject areas. Chinese, Japanese, Korean, Vietnamese, Asian Indian, White, Filipino, and students designating themselves as Two or More races outperformed the District average in all core subjects. Attached are additional reports showing the percent proficient for each middle school and subgroups as well as district-wide data.

Attendance is monitored on a monthly basis. This report uses Month 7, (March) which is the cumulative reported from the beginning of the school year to the state. Seven of our middle schools, based on Month 7 Data, have increased attendance since the 2007-08 school year, while one, Kit Carson declined in attendance. In 2011-12, the District created a Director of Attendance to assist the sites in monitoring attendance and addressing chronic truancy. One of our middle schools, Rosa Parks, is currently piloting an Early Warning System which utilizes a database tool that identifies students most at risk of dropping out, and then targeting resources to keep them in school. Indicators used are attendance, course performance and behavior. The program will be evaluated at the end of the year and may be expanded to other schools during 2012-13.

Suspensions over a four period have declined by 139 for our middle schools, with the largest decline shown by Fern Bacon, down (-52) and California, down (-44). Three schools increased in numbers of suspensions over this time, Rosa Parks (+33), Sutter (+32) and Will C. Wood (+28).

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## VII. Next Steps:

- Continue to monitor, disaggregate and discuss data with site staff in order to inform instruction, interventions and program changes
- Continue professional development for middle school teachers in the core subject areas through Common Core training and implementation
- Continue schools' work in Data Inquiry and Instructional Rounds in order to identify and implement best teaching practices at all sites
- Continue to develop intervention programs to identify and support students at risk of falling or dropping out
