LCFF, signed into law in 2013, changes how schools are funded in the state of California.		
With LCFF, funds are allocated to provide extra support for districts with a high percentage of low income, English Learners, and foster youth.		
The LCAP is the district’s plan for supporting all students. While the LCAP includes LCFF funding, it is not the district’s full budget.		
While LCFF provides some new money for districts, it also replaces existing dollars that have been used in the past to fund support for students.		
Much of SCUSD’s 2015-2016 LCFF funding – money for K-3 class size reduction and salary/benefit increases – has already been allocated.
