# Your ticket in ....

Information and materials all students will need to bring to complete the FAFSA or Dream Act Application:

- ☐ student's Social Security card and drivers license (or government-issued ID), if available
- ☐ parent's Social Security card (if available)
- ☐ **parent's federal income tax return** or W-2 forms from tax year 2015 (or 2014 to make an estimate)
- ☐ **records of untaxed income** such as child support, TANF, interest income, veterans non-education benefits, Social Security benefits
- ☐ student's W-2 forms, pay records or records of income earned during 2015
- ☐ bank account records or statements
- ☐ records of stocks, bonds or investments
- ☐ business records
- ☐ if not a US citizen, bring alien registration card (if available)
- ☐ a list of the colleges you are interested in

**Remember**, to qualify for a Cal Grant you must submit the FAFSA or Dream Act application **and** GPA verification no later than **March 2, 2016**. See your counselor to get a GPA verification.
