- Concept of school
  - Small school with more personalization. School will be no larger than 500 students, with grades 7 through 12
  - Students from the entire Sacramento City Unified School District (SCUSD) will enroll
    in the school through open enrollment
  - School to open at a temporary site in September 2007 and at the permanent site in September 2008. Permanent location of the school will be at Sojourner Truth property bordered by Swale River Way, Havenside Drive and Pocket South Canal.
  - School will offer a comprehensive 9-12 curriculum that will meet UC/CSU "a-g" criteria. Students will be able to take coursework at Sacramento State University during their senior year
  - Joint use agreement with the City of Sacramento-- to build a community public library on the same site
- \$\displaysquare\$ Status of Principal of school—will be on board on September 25, 2006
- Status of construction
  - o Architect: Max Medina from WLC Architects
  - Environmental study in progress
  - o Planning taking place -SCUSD, Library Authority and the City of Sacramento
  - Master Plan currently in development. Tentatively, plans will be shared with the community at the October Community Engagement Meeting—October 18<sup>th</sup> at G. Didion K-8 School.
