BOND MEASURES PASS!

Thank you to the voters of Sacramento who passed both the state-wide bond (Prop 47) giving public schools \$13 billion and our local general obligation bond (Measure I) providing our district \$225 million for new schools, continued facilities renovation, and educational programmatic needs.

Measure I funds will be issued incrementally over a nine year period. The first issuance is \$80 million and scheduled for release in spring 2003. A special committee was convened to determine the prioritization of Measure I funds. This committee met in January and February and will forward their recommendations to the Superintendent for review and approval.
