Comment:	<p>Regarding item 3.2 (7/16/2020 School Board meeting)</p> <p>Sac City cannot afford to use the same "makeshift" distance learning approach they used in the spring. Students, including students receiving special education services, need equitable learning across the district. To do this, there needs to be planning. SCUSD's top-down approaches do not work. Teachers need 3-5 weeks before or at the start of the fall semester to be able to just handle the special education IEP paperwork, and the ensuing meetings, completely and correctly. This is imperative in detailing what the distance learning looks like for each individual student. Sending a memo telling teachers just to do it, is not leadership. It leads to undue frustrations and inequities among service providers and to the students in which those services are being provided.
