Revision of BP 3315 (Relations with Vendors)

- 2 CFR 200.318(c)(1) states that LEAs are required to have written standards of conduct covering conflicts of interest and governing the actions of its employees engaged in the selection, award, and administration of contracts. The standards must provide for disciplinary actions to be applied for violations of such standards by officers, employees, or agents of the LEAs.
- The current version of Board Policy 3315 was adopted in 1998 and revised in 2001.

Revision of BP 3315 (Relations with Vendors) (Continued)

- The proposed policy is intended to create practices that ensure District employees and Board members appropriately engage in the selection, award, and administration of contracts and do not engage in acts that violate its standards of conduct covering conflicts of interest.
- Revisions now provide information as to when a conflict of interest arises (e.g., financial interest) and disciplinary actions regarding the same
