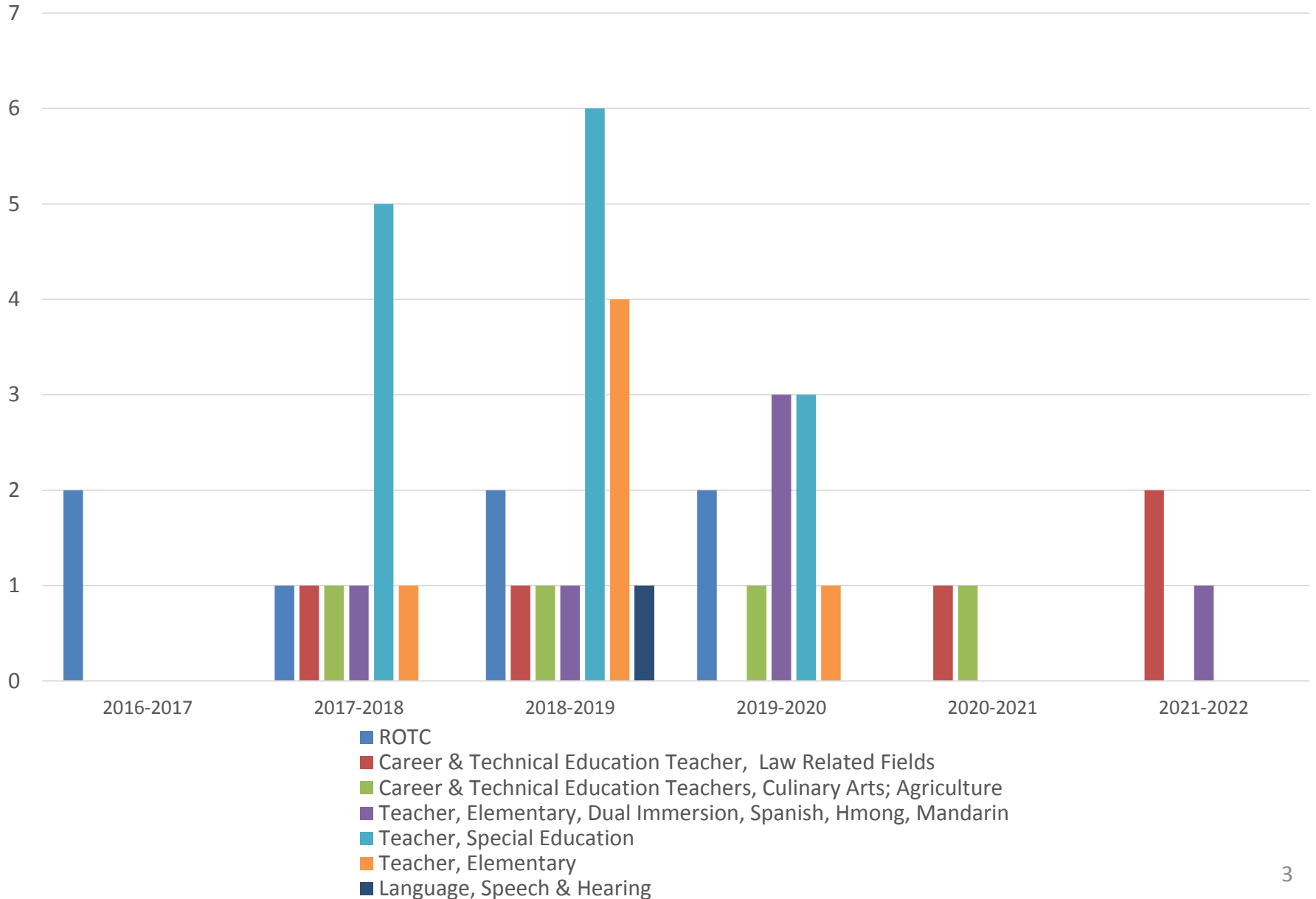

Submission of a Credential Waiver Application to the California Commission on Teacher Credentialing

- Education Code EC §44253.3 allows school districts to waive a portion of the requirement for a Certificated teacher in order to allow time for program completion
- California Commission on Teacher Credentialing (CCTC) requires that every waiver request go through a public notice process at the local level and must be Board approved in a public meeting prior to the submission of the employing agency to CCTC

2021-2022 School Year Recruitment and Retention Efforts

- The following efforts to recruit, hire, and retain fully prepared educators in identified areas of need include:
 - 5 Open Contracts by collaborating with local universities and intern programs
 - 4 Out of State educators
 - 4 Teachers completed a science residency program in collaboration with CSUS
 - 7 Teachers accepted into new science residency program in collaboration with CSUS
 - Continued efforts through Local Solutions grant that focused specifically on special education teachers

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- Waiver is being requested for the following Career and Technical Education (CTE) teacher as they complete their Clear Credential requirements, which will include English Language Authorizations (ELA):
 - Jerome Johnson, CTE credential in Health Science and Medical Technology (Hiram Johnson High School)

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- English Language Authorization is the area being requested in the waiver this evening
- This waiver will enable this teacher the opportunity to complete the requirements set forth by CCTC and to remain in their position while they continue their work with students
- Staff recommends approving this waiver request
