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Dear Board Members,

We were shocked to see the district staff's presentation to you at the September 2, 2021 board meeting stating that the district only had 33 classroom vacancies including only 13 special education vacancies. (See attached slides).


Through written comment to the school board on August 19, 2021 we shared with you the attached document titled "8.11.21 SCTA Vacancies" which the district gave to us in response to an RFI requesting all SCTA certificated vacancies. This district produced document showed 127 vacant certificated / non-management FTE as of 8/11/21. That list included 29 vacant Special Education teaching positions, 30 regular classroom positions, 6 elementary PE, 12 nurses and over 48 regular and special education support staff. These vacancies as of 8/11/21 did not include the teachers needed to implement independent study nor the over 40 intervention teachers promised to our elementary schools.

To attempt to understand how 127 vacancies on 8/11/21 became only 33 classroom vacancies in the district's presentation to this board and public on 9/2/21, we requested an updated vacancy list as of 9/9/21. See attachment labeled "Cert Vacancies as of 9_9_21". The first tab on this district produced excel spreadsheet is the classroom vacancies. The district reports 87.5 FTE of vacant classroom teaching positions. This list shows 32 vacant special education positions not the 13 that were reported to you on September 2nd. This list also includes 18.5 additional elementary positions for independent study but again does not include the intervention teachers that were promised to each elementary school. The second tab on the excel spreadsheet reveals the over 48 non-classroom vacancies.


The bottom line of all the attached documentation is that the District presentation to board claimed only 33 vacancies but the actual numbers provided by legal department shows almost triple that number of vacancies. Why was the board and public provided inaccurate information and what will this board do about that fact?
