




### Update on COVID Transmission Rates



#### Sacramento County Vaccination Rates








14.7 million children 12-171 million children 5-11nationwide are partially vaccinated


# UPDATE - SCPH Youth Athletic COVID-19 Mitigation and Face Covering Requirements

CDPH permitted local health jurisdictions to implement local exemptions to the requirement for masks during play for indoor basketball and volleyball. K-12 athletes in Sacramento County may do one of the following:

- Wear a mask at all times, including during practice, scrimmages, and game play (no testing requirements) OR
- 2. Allow players to remove masks indoors when competing, if they perform at least weekly screening testing with either PCR testing (1:1 or pooled PCR) or antigen testing of all individuals, including those who are fully vaccinated. SCUSD sports teams already participate in weekly surveillance testing

In the event of an exposure to COVID-19, any player who has unmasked close contact will be required to quarantine at home per public health requirements. Players who are fully vaccinated and remain symptom free are exempt from quarantine, *regardless of being masked or unmasked.*

Non-compliance will result in ongoing notifications that inaction will lead to enrollment in IS (Students) or corrective action (Staff) January 31, 2022 •

Fully vaccinated, approved exemption or \*enrollment in IS (Students) or corrective action (Staff)

- Timeline may be adjusted pending FDA approval for 5-11 year olds
- Students who are newly eligible have 30 days following their 12th birthday to receive their first dose
- \* Subject to the Superintendent's discretion in light of SCUSD's resources and the health and safety of SCUSD's community and recognizing the need to reach agreement with labor partners regarding an Independent Study Program that is viable in light of contractual obligations and national staffing shortages





### COVID-19 Vaccination Requirement - School Site Outreach


- We will be conducting school site outreach to families.
- We are providing them with scripts, resources and dates for multitiered outreach including:
  - Backpacking letters and forms home
  - Pulling reports from Infinite Campus to identify their students not yet in compliance
    - Targeted emails and phone calls to these families
    - Home visits before Winter Break to these families



### COVID-19 Vaccination Status Reporting Process



- Go to scusd.edu/reportvaccine
- Select staff or student form as applicable
- Fill out vaccination status regardless of student's age
- If under 12, select "not yet required"
- Attach vaccination record or exemption letter to online form (see bottom left of form for "Choose file(s)" button)



 These forms will also be available in multiple languages online as well as hard copies at each school site
