<u>Division</u> : Communications, Academic Office, Facilities
<b>Recommendation</b> : Update the Board on the Wide Open Walls partnership progress and impact to date; outline plan for remainder of fiscal year for Wide Open Walls events and school site selection.
<u>Background/Rationale</u> : Following the completion of a Wide Open Walls project at Tahoe Elementary, the Board of Education approved the funding of seven schools per fiscal year (one per trustee area) to receive 12+ murals from Wide Open Walls artists, along with an arts education component. The goal of this effort is to beautify campuses and foster a sense of school pride and increased engagement amongst its students and families.
<u>Financial Considerations</u> : Extending the Wide Open Walls partnership into the next fiscal year (2023-2024) must be decided upon by the Board of Education in budget development discussions. There is potential to expand the scope (more schools per year) if additional budget is allocated.
