Proposal to Sacramento City Teachers Association
Article 7, Assignments**

July 20, 2021 [District response to SCTA proposal of June 8, 2021]

SCTA proposes that following change to Section 7.4 of this article only:

~~The District agrees that assigning split classes (more than one grade level in regular education grades K-6) is not in the best long term interest of the students or teachers. The District agrees that it will make every effort, including adding or keeping staff at the school site, to reduce the number ~~avoid~~ split classes as well as make every effort to keep students at their neighborhood school (i.e., avoid Concapping).~~

The District proposes that Article 7, section 7.4, be revised to add the following language:

As used in this paragraph, “make every effort” shall be construed consistent with the decision in AAA Case No. 01-20-0000-1246. Under that decision, the District is not required to assign a new teacher to avoid split classes in all instances and instead this section requires the District to assign additional teachers in instances when, through the application of the District’s processes, it would be arbitrary not to assign an additional teacher.
