The purpose of the B/AAAB is to **advise** SCUSD regarding services, programs, policies and resources offered that **directly impact** the **Academic and Social Emotional Learning** outcomes of B/AA students attending school in SCUSD.



According to the CA DASHBOARD (2023), within SCUSD:

- **Black Students** perform 91.9 points **BELOW STANDARD** in ELA.
- **Black Students** Perform **132 points BELOW STANDARD** in Mathematics
- **Only 12.6 % of Black Students** are measured to be **prepared for College and Career** upon graduation
- **48.8% of Black Students** are **Chronically Absent** from school.
- Currently only **74% of Black Students** graduated from high school

As a B/AAAB member you will review/monitor SCUSD's implementation of 13 (SCUSD-Approved) Recommendations to increase the overall SUCCESS of BLACK/AFRICAN AMERICAN STUDENTS.
