




## When a student is Exempt from CAHSEE, use the following codes:

| <p>Use the <b>Met: Exempt</b> option under the Assessment Tab, Test Score Detail. This will display as a “Met” on the transcript. It is important to note that <b>previous scores should NOT be overwritten</b>.</p> <p>Please note a SCORE must still be entered in order to report the latest/highest result. Therefore, to distinguish between a true pass score (350) and a proxy score, the score of 999 will be entered.</p> <p><b>(See complete directions on Page 2 of this document).</b></p> |   |
