AD1.01 QUESTIONS:

Please confirm that existing pre-terminated data cables *do not* need to be re-tested unless issues arise.

AD1.01 ANSWER

Any data drops that are re-terminated need to be re-tested. Existing data drops that are not re-terminated can be assumed to work as-is.

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AD1.02 QUESTION

Please confirm if summer school will be in session during this project. If so, please provide the summer school schedule and occupied areas of the campus.

AD1.02 ANSWER

There is no summer school at this site.

AD1.03 QUESTION

Please confirm if the Owner's Allowance is to be 10% of the contractor's base bid, or the \$20,000 specified on page 17 of the RFP, regardless of the contractor's base bid amount.

AD1.03 ANSWER

10% of the contractor's base bid, see revised Proposal Form attached.

AD1.04 QUESTION

For demolished TCU head-end equipment (i.e. Sheet T010), please confirm if contractors are to salvage and return any specific equipment or wait for final instruction from the District once demolished.

AD1.04 ANSWER

Wait for final instruction from the District.

AD1.05 QUESTION

Please confirm if contractors are permitted to dispose of demolished materials onsite, or if offsite disposal is required.

AD1.05 ANSWER

Offsite disposal is required.

AD1.06 QUESTION

Will the District assist in coordinating a safe/secure material storage location onsite, or are contractors required to provide their own onsite storage.

AD1.06 ANSWER

Contractors are required to provide their own onsite storage.



AD1.07 QUESTION

If new clock/speaker locations are to be installed utilizing existing clock/speaker locations & pathway (i.e. existing back boxes/conduit), please confirm if there are preferred methods for maintaining uptime of both the legacy analog system and new digital system.

AD1.07 ANSWER

On previous projects, this has been addressed by temping in the existing clock and/or speaker as part of the installation of the new backbox. The existing device is temporarily secured into the new backbox with pulling line or similar. See picture for a representative example.



However, it is only necessary to keep the legacy system operational while school is in session.

AD1.08 QUESTION

Please confirm if CFCI exposed conduit pathways are to be painted by contractors with District approved paint or if base primer is acceptable.

AD1.08 ANSWER

Full paint of new conduit is required.

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AD1.09 QUESTION

Please confirm if CFCI surface mount raceway is to be painted and/or primed by contractors.

AD1.09 ANSWER

Surface raceway does not need to be primed or painted.

AD1.10 QUESTION

Please confirm if estimated Rauland Telecenter equipment lead times have been discussed with the TCU subcontractor and/or manufacturer, as long lead times may impact the proposed project schedule for prime contractors.

AD1.10 ANSWER

Per Quality Sound on 4/10/2025, all materials are currently available.

AD1.11 QUESTION

Please confirm if new clock/speaker locations are to be mounted flush (or as close as possible) to the ceiling if surface mount raceway is required to route new data cabling.

AD1.11 ANSWER

Refer to keynotes for the mounting intent at each location.

AD1.12 QUESTION

Per T400, please confirm if contractors are to provide any additional Cisco-related materials outside of the part numbers listed, per IDF.

AD1.12 ANSWER

No additional Cisco materials are required outside of the part numbers listed.

AD1.13 QUESTION

Please confirm if CAD/DWG files will be provided to the awarded contractor for As-Built purposes.

AD1.13 ANSWER

Yes.

AD1.14 QUESTION

Please confirm if both District IT and Facilities will be present and/or available during the activation and cutover phases, given the fact multiple new/existing systems will be interfaced with to facilitate a smooth transition to the new Telecenter solution.

11 The term "Bidder" means any person or persons, firm, partnership, corporation, or combination thereof making 12 an offer, a proposal, or submitting a response to the Bidding Documents with the intent of forming a Contract 13 with the District on the Project.

The term "Contractor" means the Bidder to whom the Contract is awarded.

The term "Participation Goal" or "Goal" means a numerically expressed DVBE objective that Bidders are required to make efforts to achieve in accordance with Section 17076.11 of the Education Code.

The term "Equipment Broker" means a DVBE that rents equipment **unless** one or more disabled veterans has at least a 51% ownership of the equipment. If the equipment is owned by one or more disabled veterans, then, to avoid being an Equipment Broker, each disabled veteran owner shall, prior to performance, submit a declaration signed by the disabled veteran owner stating that the owner is a disabled veteran and providing the name, address, telephone number, and tax identification number of the disabled veteran owner.

DVBE Goals:

In accordance with Education Code section 17076.11, the District has a Participation Goal for DVBEs of three percent (3%). Prior to, and as a condition precedent for, final payment, the Contractor shall provide documentation to the District identifying the amount paid to DVBEs under the Contract, so that the District can assess its success at meeting this Participation Goal.


