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Overview of 2012-2013 Assessment and Accountability Results:

The following report provides achievement information on Elementary, K-8, Middle and High Schools.

Sacramento City Unified School District currently operates 42 elementary schools, 10 K-8 schools, 7 Middle Schools and 13 High Schools. **Elementary Schools:** A.M. Winn, Abraham Lincoln, Bowling Green Chacon, Bowling Green McCoy, Bret Harte, Camellia Basic, Caroline Wenzel, Cesar Chavez, Crocker/Riverside, David Lubin, Earl Warren, Edward Kemble, Elder Creek, Ethel I. Baker, Ethel Phillips, Golden Empire, H. W. Harkness, Hollywood Park, Hubert H. Bancroft, Isador Cohen, James W. Marshall, John Bidwell, John Cabrillo, John D. The California Standards Tests (CST) are designed to assess students' achievement of California's academic content standards in English Language Arts, mathematics, science and history/social science. California Modified Assessments (CMA) allow students who have an Individualized Education Plan (IEP) and are receiving grade level instruction and are not likely to achieve grade level proficiency within the year covered by the IEP to demonstrate their achievement of the content standards in core areas. These tests, along with the California Alternate Performance Assessment (CAPA), designed for students with significant cognitive disabilities, and the Standards-based Tests in Spanish (STS), designed for Spanish-speaking English Learners in U. S. schools for less than 12 months, form the basis of the California Standardized Testing and Reporting program (STAR). Students are expected to meet the California standards in English Language Arts, Math, Science and History/Social Science performance levels are used to measure student achievement. These are *Advanced*, *Proficient*, *Basic*, *Below Basic* and *Far Below Basic*. The expectation for meeting a standard is that a student achieved the *Advanced or Proficient* level.

Driving Governance:

Pillar I (College and Career Ready Students) of the Districts Strategic Plan 2010-2014 requires that we continue to raise the achievement bar for all students in the district. "We will provide students with a relevant, rigorous and well-rounded education that includes 21st-century career exploration, visual and

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performing arts and that meets four-year college and university requirements. Our goal is for all schools to hold students to the academic expectations.”

Achievement Results for 2013:

- In the area of English/Language Arts, at the Elementary level, students were 46% proficient (or above), a decrease of 3%. Schools with the largest achievement growth in ELA were: Maple (+16%), Oak Ridge (+6%), Fruit Ridge (+3%), Bret Harte (+2%) and Mark Hopkins (+2%).
- In the area of Mathematics, at the Elementary level, students were 56% proficient (or above), a decrease of 3%. Schools with the largest achievement growth in Mathematics were: Maple Elementary (+19%), Edward Kemble (+5%), William Land (+5%), Mark Hopkins (+4%) and Peter Burnett (+3%).
- In the area of English/Language Arts, in the K-8 schools, students were 49% proficient (or above), a decrease of 6%. Schools with the highest growth were: Father Keith B. Kenny (+9%) and the John Morse Therapeutic Center (+5%).
- In the area of Mathematics, in the K-8 schools, students were 50% proficient (or above), a decrease of 3%. Schools with the highest growth were: John Morse Therapeutic Center (+22%), Father Keith B. Kenny (+16%), Caleb Greenwood (+7%), Leonardo Da Vinci (+5%).
- In the area of English/Language Arts, at the Middle School level, students were 51% proficient (or above), a decrease of 4%. Two schools saw achievement growth: Will C. Wood (+2%) and Sam Brannan (+1%).
- In the area of Mathematics, at the Middle School level, students were 51% proficient (or above), an increase of 2%. Three schools saw growth in Proficiency Levels: Fern Bacon (+15%), California Middle (+6%) and Sutter (+2%).
- In the area of English/Language Arts, at the High School level, students were 45% proficient (or above), an increase of 1%. The schools with the highest increase in achievement were: Capital City School (+4%), The MET (+3%) and George Washington Carver (+2%).
- In grade 8, students are assessed in Social Science. 45% of SCUSD students were proficient (or above), a decrease of 1%. Schools with the most gains were: Caleb Greenwood (+25%), Leonardo Da Vinci (+21%), Will C. Wood (+17%), Alice Birney Waldorf-Inspired (+12%) and MLK, Jr. (+10%).

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- In 2011-2012, the District graduation rate was 79.9%. This is an increase of 5.3%.
- In 2011-2012, the District cohort dropout rate was 11.5%, this is a decrease of 6.5%.
- On the CAHSEE exam, for Grade 10 students, 78% of students were proficient in Mathematics, a 4% decrease. 76% of students were proficient in English/Language Arts, also a 4% decrease.

Next Steps:

- District staff and school leaders reviewed all achievement data to fully understand trends in student learning. As schools collect additional information on student achievement throughout the year, school teams will continue to review, reflect, and make changes to support student learning.
- To address some of the gaps that in the 2012-13 CST data, schools will receive support and training on:
 - Data Inquiry Teams: These teams allow schools to closely review the data by specific subgroups and tie that achievement to practices in the classroom.
 - Common Core: Schools are also participating in deeper Common Core training that will provide the knowledge, skills, and tools necessary for teachers and school staff to instruct students at a high level of rigor.
 - Social-Emotional Learning: To develop the characteristics and habits of mind that we know are critical for future success, schools will receive support on how to develop and integrate a strong and purposeful SEL curriculum into their sites.

Attachments:

The attachments provided here give a more in-depth look at student achievement across schools and by reported subgroups.

- In the area of Mathematics, at the High School level, students were 20% proficient (or above). There was no change in proficiency. The Schools with the largest achievement growth were: The MET (+3%), Capital City (+3%) and New Technology High (+1%).

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- In grades 5 and 8 students are assessed in Science. In Grade 5, 42% of SCUSD students were proficient (or above), a decrease of 2%. For all schools grade 8, 60% were proficient (or above) which is the same achievement level as the prior year. Schools with the most gains in science were: Maple (+42%), John Morse Therapeutic Center (+27%), Mark Twain (+19%), Pony Express (+16%) and Phoebe A. Hearst (+16%).

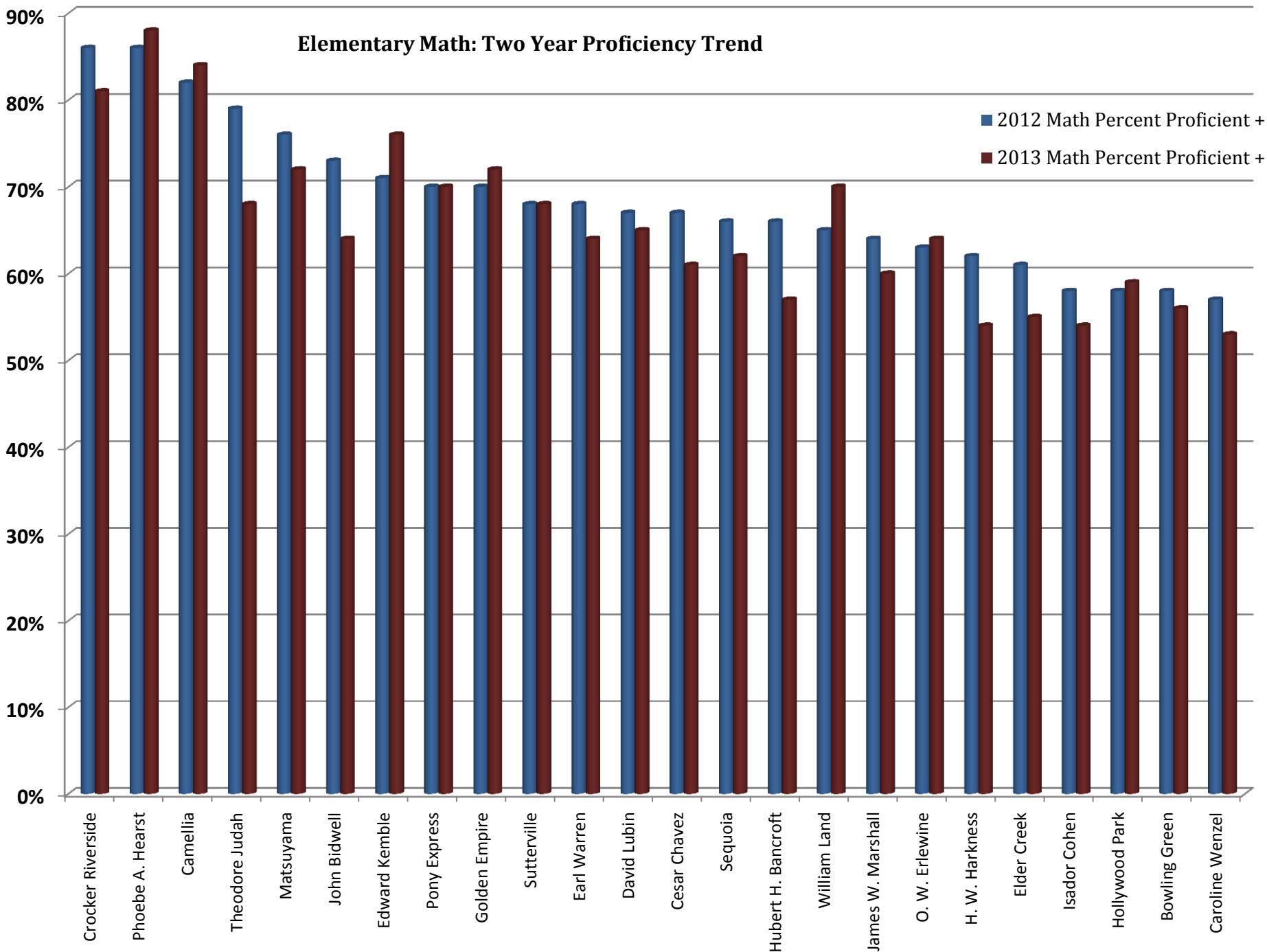

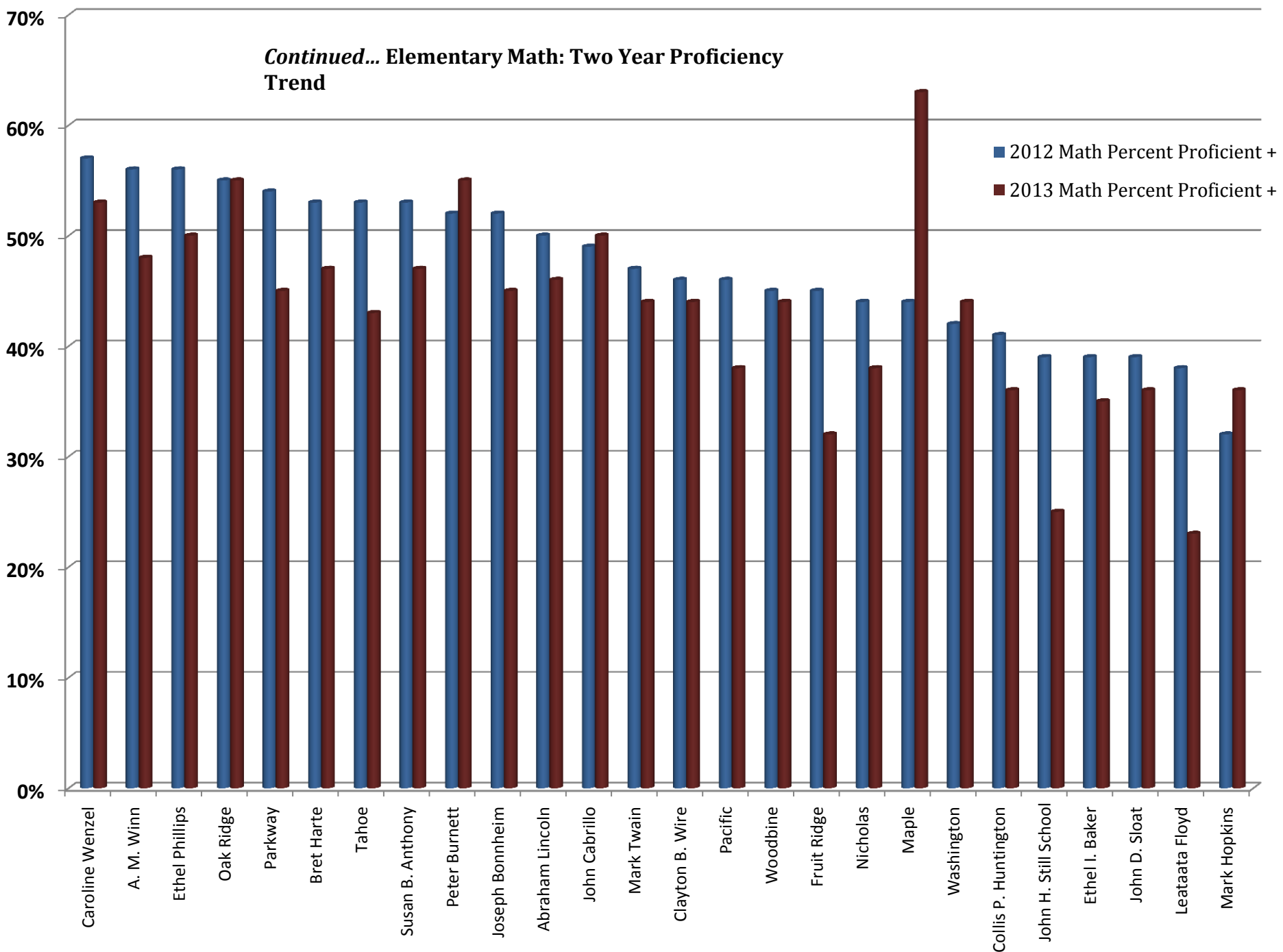

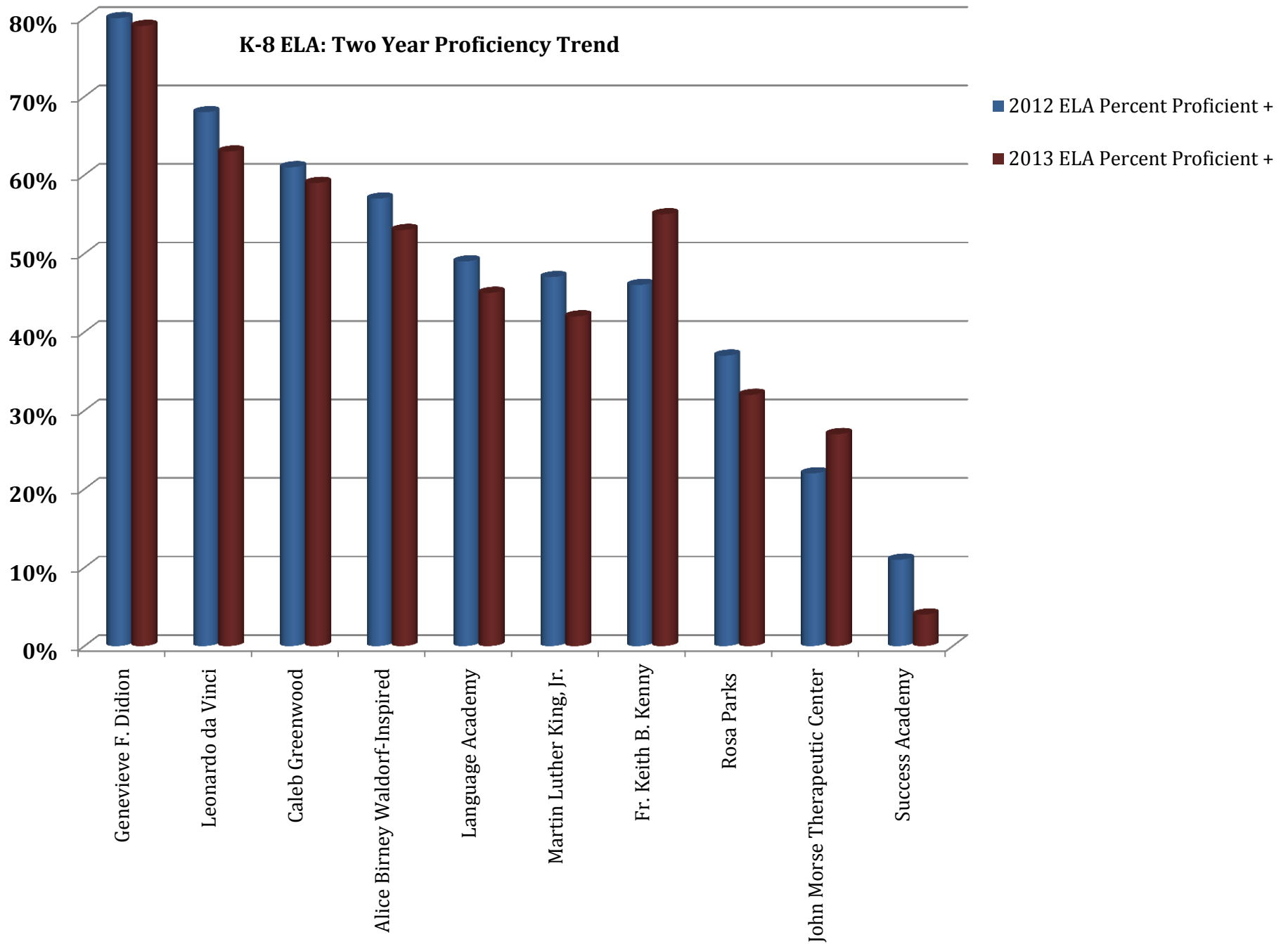
Elementary Math: Two Year Proficiency Trend

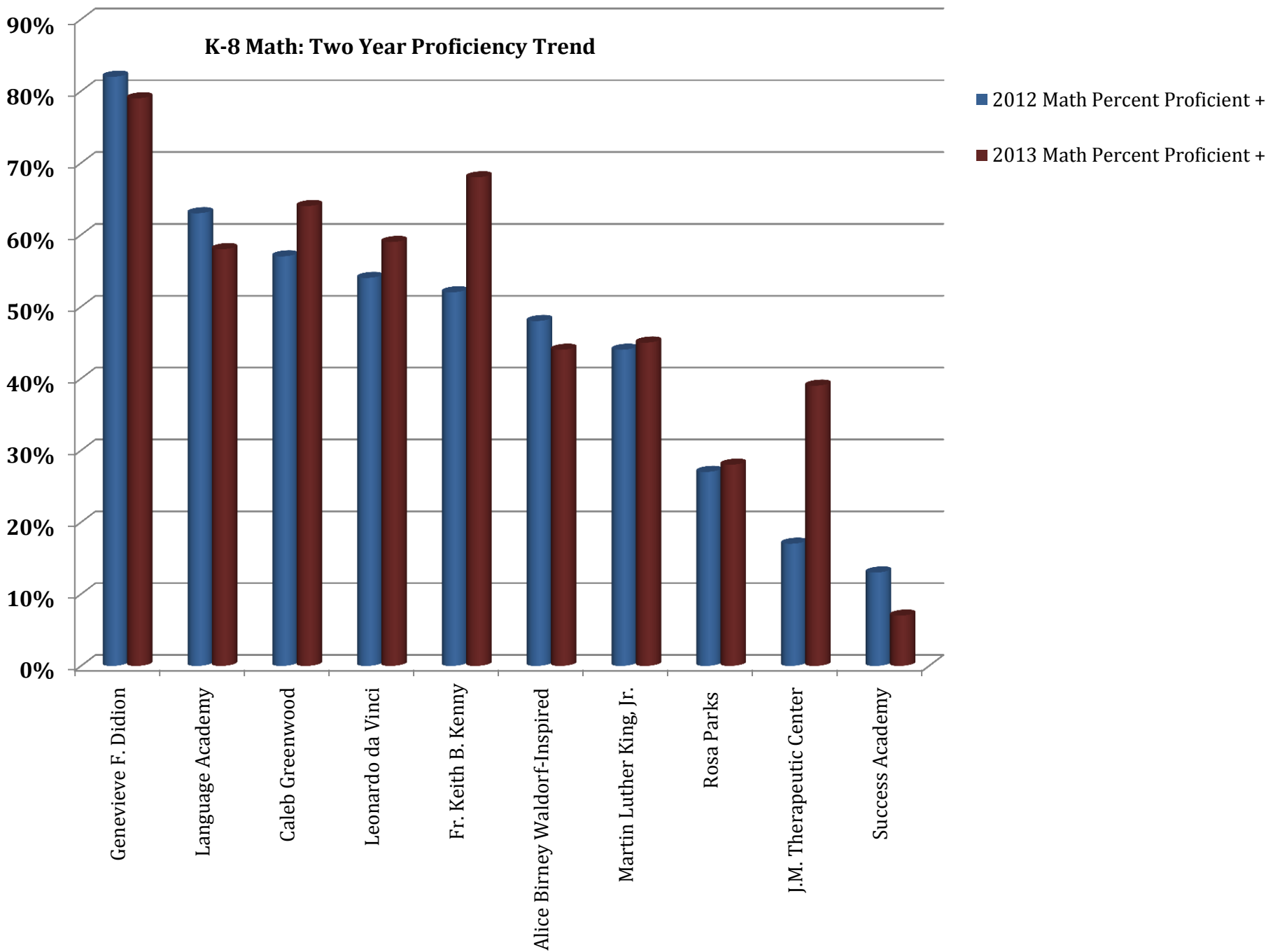


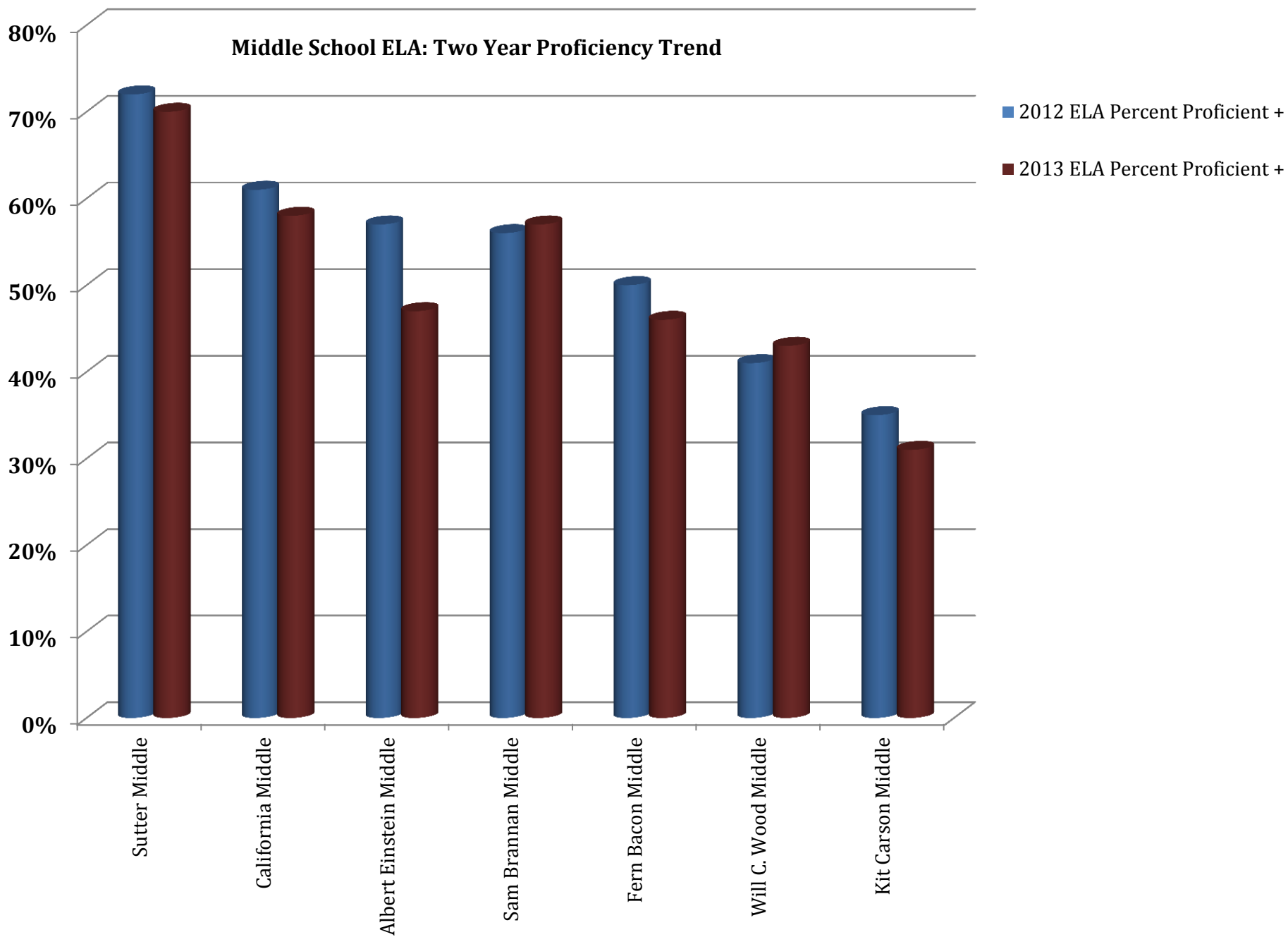

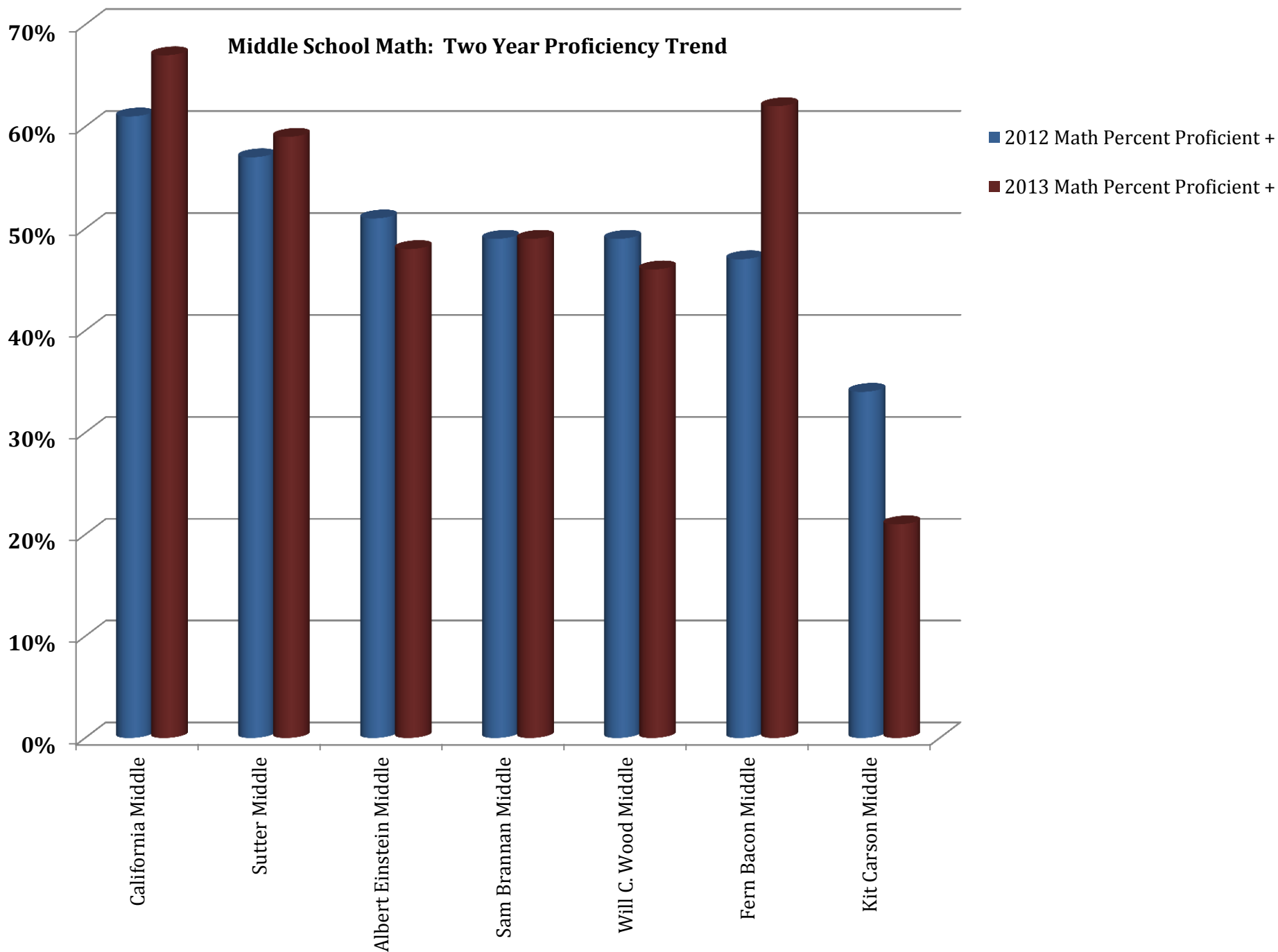


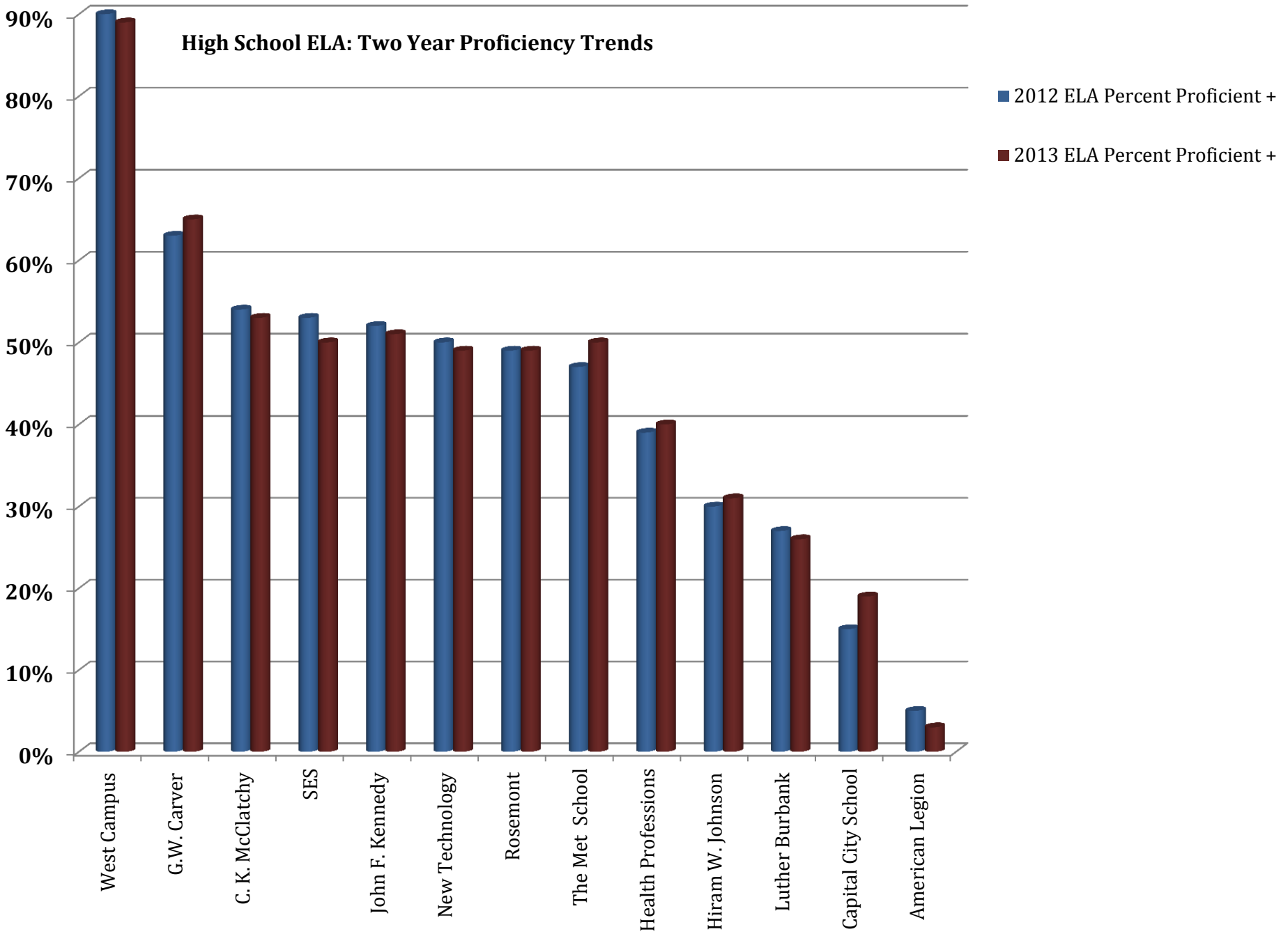
K-8 ELA: Two Year Proficiency Trend





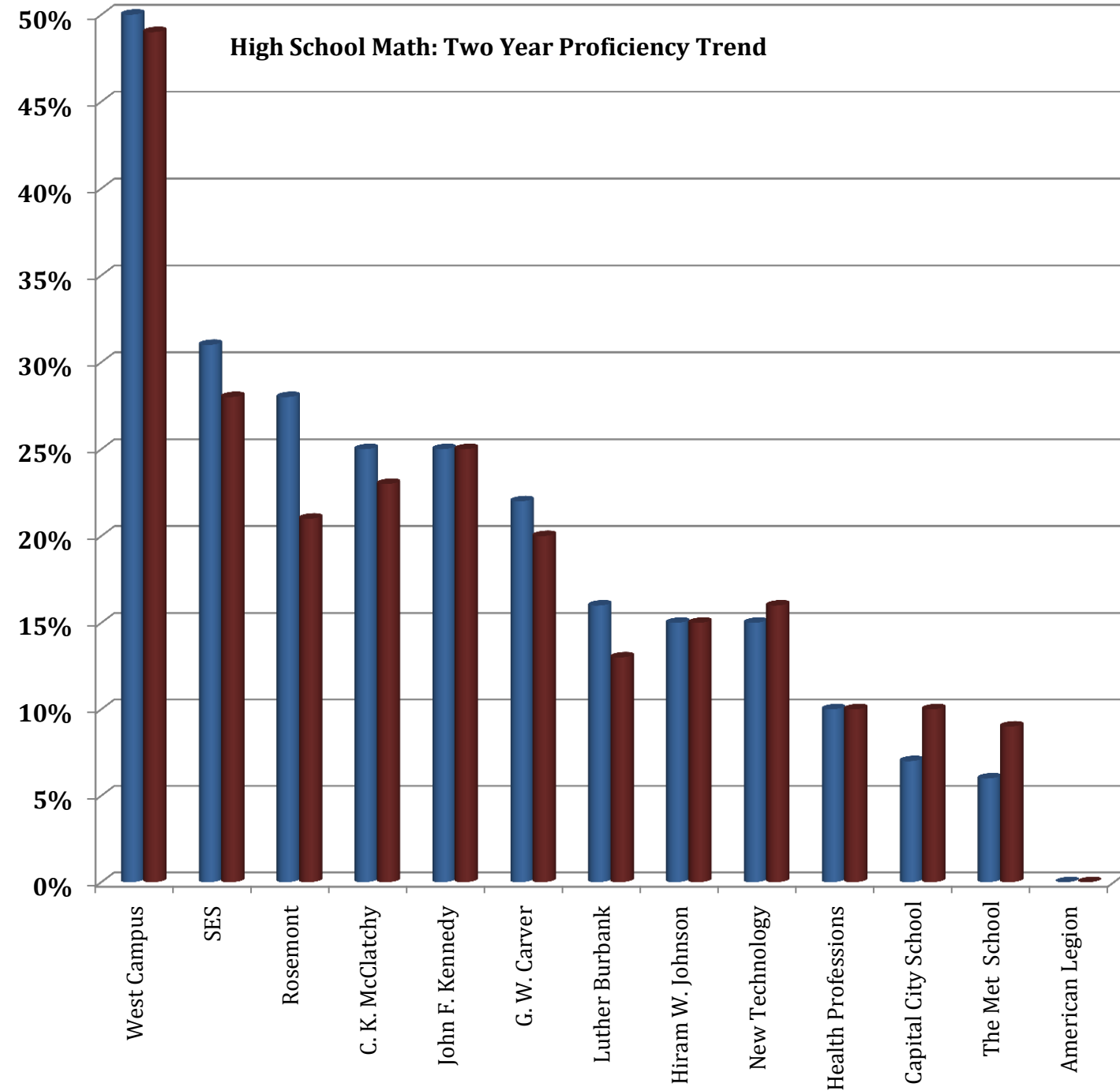






High School Math: Two Year Proficiency Trend
