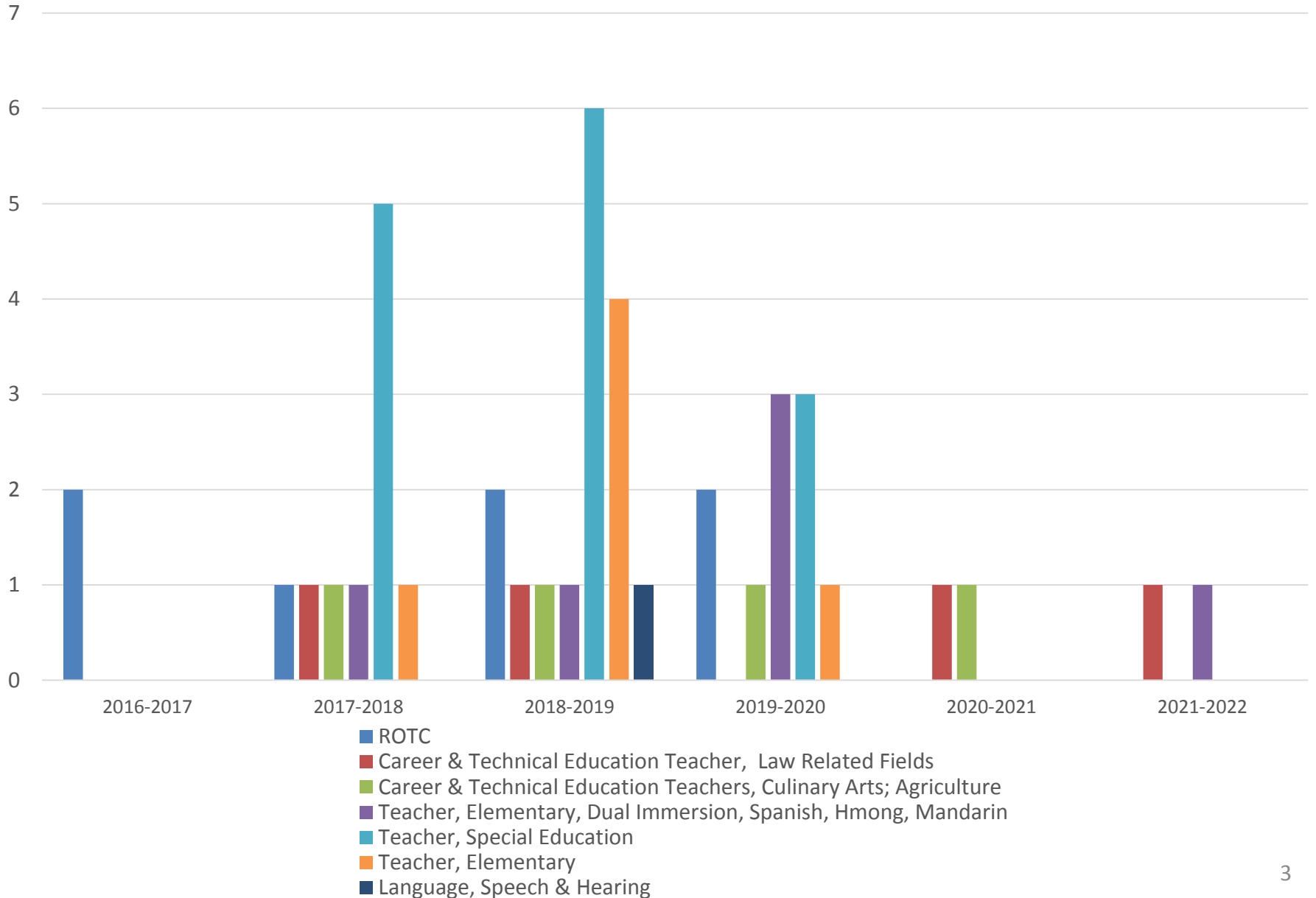

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- Education Code EC §44253.3 allows school districts to waive a portion of the requirement for a Certificated teacher in order to allow time for program completion
- California Commission on Teacher Credentialing (CCTC) requires that every waiver request go through a public notice process at the local level and must be Board approved in a public meeting prior to the submission of the employing agency to CCTC

School Years 2017/2018, 2018/2019, 2019/2020, 2020/2021, and 2021/2022 Credential Waiver Request



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- Waiver is being requested for the following Career and Technical Education (CTE) teacher as they complete their Clear Credential requirements, which will include English Language Authorizations (ELA):
- Waiver is being requested for the following Dual Immersion Spanish teacher as they complete their Bilingual Authorization Credential requirements
 - Stephen Steinberg, CTE credential in Arts, Media, and Entertainment (Sacramento New Technology High School)
 - Natalie Perez Alvarez, Teacher, Elementary (Bowling Green - Chacon Language & Science Academy)

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- English Language Authorization and Bilingual Authorization are the areas being requested in the two waivers this evening
- These waivers will enable the two teachers the opportunity to complete the requirements set forth by CCTC and to remain in their positions while they continue their work with students
- Staff recommends approving this waiver request
