<u>Background/Rationale</u>: May has been designated as Mental Health Awareness Month and Wednesday, May 7, 2025 is designated as National Children's Mental Health Awareness Day, both dedicated to raising awareness of youth, their families and all community members who experience emotional, behavioral, and mental health challenges.

Sacramento City Unified School District continues to support the whole child and address the social and emotional needs of our students, especially as rates of youth mental illness and suicide risk climb nationally.
