Project Highlights:

- · Replace exterior light fixtures with energy efficient light fixtures
- · Work timeline is December 2023-June 2024
- · 25 sites will receive work
- · Average of 90% energy savings per light fixture
- · Will receive SMUD energy retrofit rebate
- Expected project payback period of 8 years
- District negotiated 10 year material warranty (1 year typical)

Procurement Method

- · Government Code 4217 Energy Service Contract
- Post a notice of a public hearing to determine validity of using Government Code 4217
- · Board holds a public hearing to determine whether the anticipated energy cost savings of proposed project has been reasonably established
