COLLEGE & CAREER READINESS

California Department of Education A18-00053 07/01/17 – 06/30/19: California Partnership Academy (CPA) grants support eight (8) CPAs at four (4) comprehensive high schools serving 828 students in the district. These academies are focused on smaller learning communities that are career-themed. Academies serve students in grades 10-12 and are structured as schools-within-a-school. Academies in the district follow the Linked Learning approach as their model. The curriculum incorporates integrated academic and career technical education, mentoring, and internships. Academy leadership is provided by a committed team of teachers as well as active business and post-secondary partnerships.

CPA funds are used to purchase industry specific equipment, software, transportation for field trips and professional learning services. The collaboration between core academic instruction and Career Technical Education helps to produce both college and career ready students. These programs also strengthen relationships with local industry and postsecondary education partners.

Examples of critical outcomes from these grant dollars include:

- Industry Standard Experiences CPA funding allows SCUSD CPAs to acquire industry standard equipment, tools, supplies, and other resources.
- Prepared Students Industry standard software and tools give students access to real-world experiences inside the classroom. Combined with worksite visits/tours and work-based learning opportunities, CPA students are better prepared for success in both postsecondary education and the workplace.
- Skilled Teachers CPA teachers receive professional learning experiences that allow them to stay current in their respective fields as well as hone their teaching skills.
- Involved Community and Industry Partners Work based learning opportunities with community and industry partners.

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

- 5. No Agency. Grantee is solely responsible for all activities supported by the grant funds, the content of any product created with the grant funds, and the manner in which any such product may be disseminated. This Agreement shall not create any agency relationship, partnership, or joint venture between the parties, and Grantee shall make no such representation to anyone.
- 6. Indemnification. Grantee irrevocably and unconditionally agrees, to the fullest extent permitted by law, to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless The Endowment, its officers, directors, employees, and agents, from and against any and all claims, liabilities, losses, and expenses (including reasonable attorneys' fees) directly, indirectly, wholly, or partially arising from or in connection with any act or omission of Grantee, its employees, or agents, in applying for or accepting the grant, in expending or applying the grant funds, or in carrying out any project or program to be supported by the grant, except to the extent that such claims, liabilities, losses, or expenses arise from or in connection with any act or omission of The Endowment, its officers, directors, employees, or agents.
