Recommendation: Requesting consent on Expanded Learning Opportunities Program (ELO_P) plan

Background/Rationale: The Expanded Learning Opportunities Program provides funding for before school, after school and summer school enrichment programs for transitional kinder (TK) through sixth grade students. This funding was initiated in fiscal year 2021-22 by Assembly Bill (AB) and then amended by AB 167.

Financial Considerations: School Districts with 80% or more unduplicated students (English Learner, Foster Youth and students on Free and Reduced Lunch) in TK-6 are prioritized and receive funding at a higher rate (\$1,170 per students). SCUSD's percentage for unduplicated students is 72.5% and we have 15,232 unduplicated students in TK-6 grades. Our total funding allocation for school year 2021-22 is \$10,238,922.00 at the rate of \$672.00 per student.

LCAP Goal(s): LCAP Goal 2: Provide every SCUSD student an educational program with standards-aligned instruction, fidelity to district programs and practices, and robust, rigorous learning experiences inside and outside the classroom so that all students can meet or exceed state standards.

LCAP Goal 3: Provide every student the specific academic, behavioral, social-emotional, and mental and physical health supports to meet their individual needs especially English Learners, Students with Disabilities, Foster Youth, Homeless Youth, African American students, American Indian or Alaska Native students, Hispanic/Latino students, Native Hawaiian or Pacific Islander students, and other student groups whose

outcomes indicate the greatest need – so that all students can remain fully engaged in school and access core instruction.
