Recommendation: This is an information item. No Board action is recommended.

Background/Rationale: The SCUSD School Board authorizes 5 locally funded or "dependent" charter schools. These schools are Bowling Green Elementary (comprised of the Chacon Language and Science Academy and the McCoy Academy of Excellence), George Washington Carver School of Arts and Science, New Joseph Bonnheim Community Charter, Sacramento New Technology Early College High School, and The Met Sacramento.

Each of these schools is their own Local Education Authority (LEA), with their own local steering committee that reviews use of public funds, but the SCUSD School Board is the ultimate governing body. The California Department of Education has required that all LEAs present a mid-year update on their LCAP by February 28. Each school has presented this information to their local steering committees and each committee has recommended to move forward with presentation to the SCUSD School Board.
