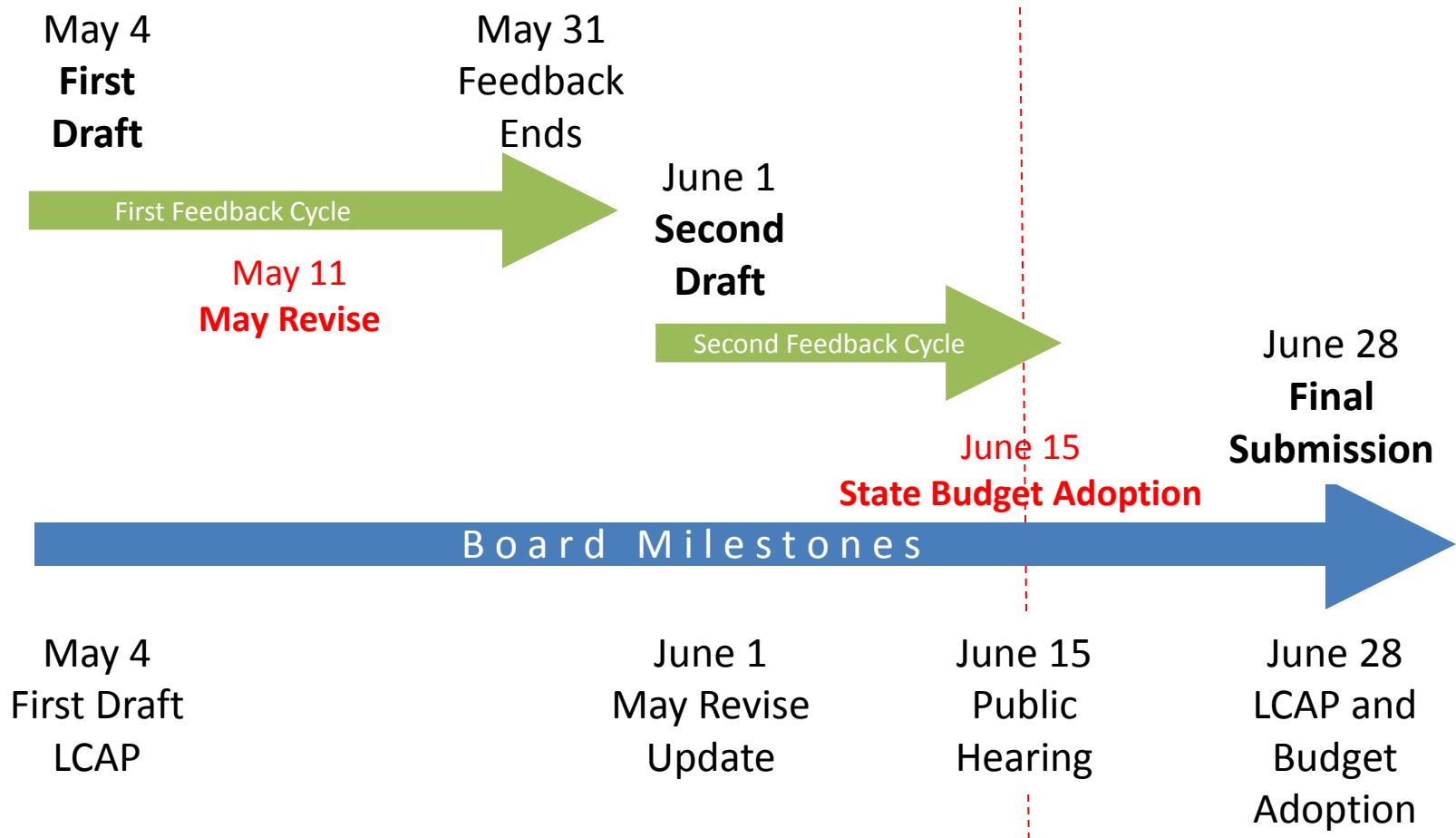

The LCAP Public Hearing

- Education Code (EC) 52062 (b)(1) requires a public hearing on the draft LCAP
- As required, this hearing is being held at the same meeting as the district budget hearing
- Both LCAP and budget are adopted at the same meeting, prior to July 1.

Updating the Draft

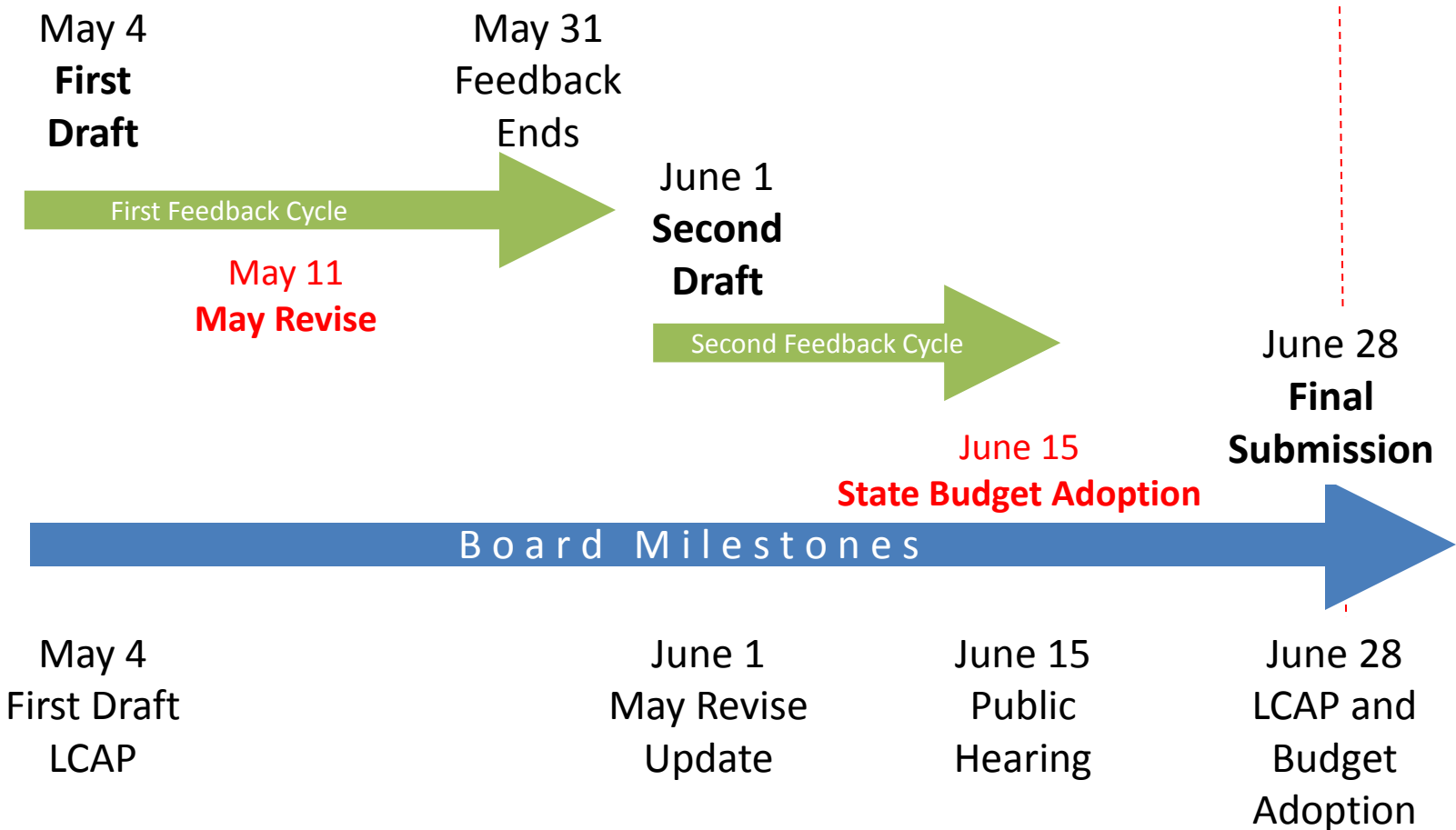
- The “May Revise” board presentation on June 1, 2017, provided more budget detail and clarified board priorities
- Community voice and testimony impacted LCAP content
- Executive and technical review to ensure alignment with priorities and structural requirements

Community Impact

- Expanded learning programs (before- and after-school, summer, intersession) received additional funding to backfill lost grant funds
- Parent participation in decision-making will be supported by language translations of the LCAP, SPSA and a comprehensive infographic explaining the LCAP
