### Comprehensive Safe Schools Plan

- By law, each school must submit plan annually
- Plans address School Culture and Climate as well as Safety Procedures
- Stakeholder participation
- Review underway

# Safety of Transitioning Students, Families

- Continue to work with Sac PD, City of Sacramento and Sacramento County to identify safe walking routes to receiving schools
  - Maps will be provided to families at all seven schools
- Working with SCUSD Transportation Dept. to identify bus pick up/drop off locations
- Crossing Guards/Walking Attendants will be deployed in many neighborhoods



#### **Needs Assessment**

- Current resources afford basic safety and security for all students and families
- Current staffing levels:
  - **8 School Resource Officers**
  - **54 Campus Monitors** 
    - **3 GVPI Specialists**

#### **Needs Assessment**
