

Smarter Balanced

Students in grades 3–8 and 11 will receive full-length tests for both English language arts/literacy and mathematics, with approximately seven to eight hours of total testing time for each student. Every device used for testing must have the <u>secure browser</u> installed. Stable, high-speed Internet is required.
