Before the fair, know the answer the following questions:

- Do you want to attend a two or four year institution? Co-ed or single sex institution?
- What size of school do you want to attend?
- What programs of study are you considering?
- How far from home do you want to go?
- Do you wish to participate in any specific extra-curricular activities or athletics?
- Do you want to attend a school in an urban, suburban or rural environment?

Ask the college reps questions that are important to you!

- Looking at the information on my college Card*, do you think that I would be eligible for your college and in the major I want? (*Bring cards to leave with at least 5 colleges: name, address, e-mail, include GPA and SAT/ACT scores)
- Is there anything that you would recommend that I do to enhance my chances for admission?
- What percent of students graduate in four years? Five? Why? What percent of your students are from the immediate area?
- What is unique about your campus? What is the best time to visit your campus?
- How do I sign up for a tour, arrange for an overnight stay and get information about Open House? Is an interview necessary?
- What is the housing like for freshmen? How will I get around if I don't have a car? What is the policy on having a car?
- Do you have sororities and fraternities? When would freshmen join?
- How large are the freshman classes? What percent are taught by professors and what percent by teaching assistants?
- What financial aid is available? Do you offer athletic and/or merit scholarships?
- Are any majors impacted? (Impacted: number of applicants exceeds available spaces, and the difficulty of being accepted into that major is increased) How easy is it to change majors? Can a student do two majors?
- What special services are available, i.e. for the physically disabled, learning disabled, etc.?
- Do you have an Honors Program for freshmen? How do I qualify for it?
- Do you provide Career Planning and Placement Services ?
- What percent of your students are accepted into their first choice graduate school or career?
