# 2021-22 SBAC Results with Attendance, and Suspension Results

20221028 Summary 2022 SBAC

#### **Executive Summary**

- A total of 38% of students met or exceeded standards in English Language Arts, and a total of 27% achieved the same performance in Math in 2021-22.
- Results from the 2021-22 SBAC will likely need to be treated as "baseline" data as students in SCUSD did not
  participate in the SBAC during the 2019-20 and 2020-21 school years due to the COVID-19 pandemic and
  related emergency and distance learning.
- Although 2021-22 SBAC results are baseline, these results indicate a learning loss since the district last
  participated in the SBAC during the 2018-19 school year. On average, the number of students who met
  standards in both subjects on the SBAC were about 5-6 percentage points higher in 2018-19 than the baseline
  2021-22 preliminary results.
- Performance by grade level varied in both subjects. The percent of students who met or exceeded ELA standards was highest in grade 7 (45%) and lowest in grade 3 (34%). However, grade 3 was the highest performing grade level in Math (34%) and students in grade 11 performed the lowest in Math (17%).
- The achievement gaps between White and Black / African American (B/AA) students persisted into the 2021-22 SBAC results. The percentage of White students who met or exceeded standards in ELA and Math was approximately 41 and 40 percentage points, respectively, higher than B/AA students in both subjects.
