- A current transcript

APPLICATION ATTACHMENTS AND REQUIREMENTS:

Any student who meets the stated qualifications must complete an online application. The completed application must be accompanied by the following documents.

- 1. Student Essay (essay must be typed in the appropriate box on the application, must be 750 words or less and must include the following):
 - Essay about yourself. Please include how being a student athlete at Kennedy has prepared you for college
- 2. Two Letters of Recommendation (MUST INCLUDE):

Both letters must include a phone number and contact information, and if possible, should be on official letterhead.

- One from a current Kennedy High School teacher; and
- □ One from a current Kennedy High School coach

3. Transcript:

□ An unofficial transcript of student's high school record, including the first semester of your senior year
