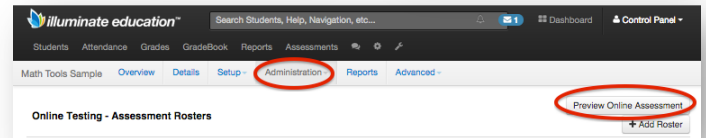
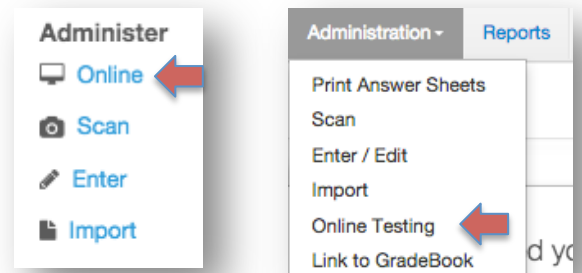


## Setup Online Testing

- 1 Select the **Assessments** tab, click **List Assessments**
- 2 Find your assessment, click on the assessment title
- 3 Preview your online assessment prior to administering it. To access online testing options you can:
  - Use the “Hello there.” window, click **Online**, click **Preview Online Assessment**
  - Use the **Administration** sub-tab, click **Online Testing**, click **Preview Online Assessment**



## Create a Testing Window (Add Roster)

- 1 Access the **Online Testing** options, via the “Hello There.” window or the Administration sub-tab, click **Add Roster**
- 2 Select the testing window start and end times for each class or period. Think about when students can access.
- 3 Review the **Online Testing – Administration Settings** to set further security restrictions and to **Randomize Answer Choices**.
- 4 Click **Save**.

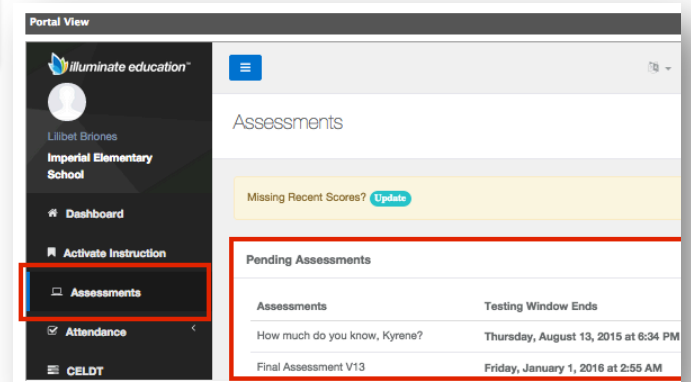

- 5 All the testing windows (rosters) you have setup will be displayed with the current status. Notice at anytime you can edit or delete the roster. If you need to assign a different group of students to this assessment at a different day or time, select **Add Roster** and repeat the the steps above.

## Student Portal View

- 1 Search and select a student to access **Student Profile**
- 2 Locate or add the widget **Portal View**
  - **Don't see it?** Click **Add Widgets** to add **Portal View**. It will appear at the bottom of the page

Click the **Assessments** tab on the left of the widget to view **Pending Assessments** to verify the setup of your Online Testing Roster.



- 3 All recent assessments, results, and data will be available for review here as well.
- 4 To disable portal access to assessment results, the test author can use the Setup sub-tab from within the assessment, and edit the Information section.
