



# Update on COVID Transmission Rates

## Epi-Curve by Episode Date

- **364** new cases
- **13.2** cases per 100K (7-day avg)
- **2.8%** test positivity (7-day rate)

# UPDATE - SCPH Youth Athletic COVID-19 Mitigation and Face Covering Requirements

CDPH permitted local health jurisdictions to implement local exemptions to the requirement for masks during play for indoor basketball and volleyball. K-12 athletes in Sacramento County may do one of the following:

1. Wear a mask at all times, including during practice, scrimmages, and game play (no testing requirements) OR
2. Allow players to remove masks indoors when competing, if they perform at least weekly screening testing with either PCR testing (1:1 or pooled PCR) or antigen testing of all individuals, including those who are fully vaccinated. *SCUSD sports teams already participate in weekly surveillance testing*

In the event of an exposure to COVID-19, any player who has unmasked close contact will be required to quarantine at home per public health requirements. Players who are fully vaccinated and remain symptom free are exempt from quarantine, *regardless of being masked or unmasked.*



- *Timeline may be adjusted pending FDA approval for 5-11 year olds*
- *Students who are newly eligible have 30 days following their 12th birthday to receive their first dose*
- *\* Subject to the Superintendent's discretion in light of SCUSD's resources and the health and safety of SCUSD's community and recognizing the need to reach agreement with labor partners regarding an Independent Study Program that is viable in light of contractual obligations and national staffing shortages*



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## COVID-19 VACCINATION AND EXEMPTION RECORD SUBMISSION FOR SCUSD STUDENTS

**Due Date: Tuesday, November 30, 2021.**

The Sacramento City Unified School District's ("District") Board of Education passed a [resolution](#) on October 12, 2021 requiring all District staff and students (including dependent charter school and Adult Education students) aged 12 and older receive the COVID-19 vaccination as a condition to accessing in-person instruction in order to best ensure the health and safety of all students, staff, and community and best protect against future disruptions to full-time, in-person instruction threatened by the COVID-19 pandemic.

The Board allows exemptions for valid medical reasons, personal belief and religious belief for students. Students who are not vaccinated and have an approved exemption must participate in regular and routine COVID testing. You may register at <https://bit.ly/3mdkT3> for COVID-19 testing.



**DOCUMENTATION OPTIONS AVAILABLE**

1. Attach your digital COVID-19 vaccine records from <https://myvaccinerecord.cdph.ca.gov/>.
2. Attach a picture/file of your COVID-19 Vaccination Record Card (issued by the Department of Health and Human Services Centers for Disease Control & Prevention or WHO Yellow Card) or proof from your Health Care Provider. Name, DOB and dose date must be legible and clear.
3. California Immunization Registry (CAIR) Lookup: provide consent for a Health Services team member to

- Select staff or student form as applicable
- Fill out vaccination status regardless of student's age
- If under 12, select "not yet required"
- Attach vaccination record or exemption letter to online form (see bottom left of form for "Choose file(s)" button)



- These forms will also be available in multiple languages online as well as hard copies at each school site
