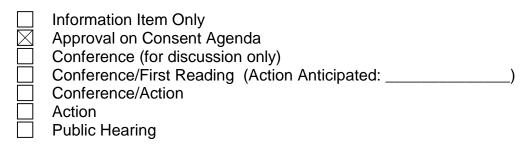

Subject: Approval of Single Plans for Student Achievement for K-12 Schools



Division: Strategy and Innovation Office

<u>Recommendation</u>: Approve the 2015-16 Single Plans for Student Achievement for K-12 schools.

Background/Rationale: Each school participating in state and federally funded programs, per the Consolidated Application (ConApp), is required to develop or update its Single Plan for Student Achievement (SPSA) on an annual basis. The stated purpose of the SPSA is to "improve the academic performance of all pupils to the level of performance goals, as established by the Academic Performance Index." (Ed. Code 64001)

Financial Considerations: Plans outline actions that will be supported with state and federal funds as allocated to each respective site.
