Background/Rationale: This is an update on the status of “Re Imagine” school safety outcome from Board Resolution. To provide a summary of next steps.

Financial Considerations: Sixteen positions have been approved. ESSER will fund one Safety Intervention and Response Coordinator and ten Lead Campus Supervisors with one-time monies. Five Safety Officers will be funded from the General funds that previously supported the Safety Resource Officers. Total annual cost will be approximately \$1,497,818.
