# Special Education Federal & State Timelines

## Special Education Timelines

#### Federal & State Requirements

- > 34 CFR § 300.301(c)--Assessment Timeline
  - Requires that the initial evaluation "[m]ust be conducted within 60 days of receiving parental consent for the evaluation"
- ➤ Education Code 56043(f)(1)—Assessment Timeline
  - Requires that an IEP resulting from "an assessment of a pupil shall be developed within a total time not to exceed <u>60 calendar</u> <u>days</u>.
- ➤ Education Code Section 56043(a)—Assessment Plans
  - The parent or guardian of the pupil shall be given, in writing, a proposed assessment plan within <u>15 days</u> of the referral for assessment

## Special Education Timelines


- District has special education policies and procedures in place for documenting and responding to initial special education evaluations, re-evaluations, and related procedural safeguards for parents and timelines as required by state and federal regulations located at Administrative Regulation 6164.4 (Identification of Individuals for Special Education)

#### **CDE & District Conclusions**

- The District is out of compliance because it failed to meet the requirements of:
  - ➤ Education Code Section 56043(f)(1)
  - Education Code Section 56321(a)
  - ➤ 34 CFR Section 300.111



Assessments were not conducted from March 2020 - February 26, 2021

#### Assessment Update

#### Assessment Defined

Assessments are considered all of the special education standardized assessments that are agreed to on an individual student's assessment plan <u>and</u> the IEP meeting was held.

#### February 26, 2021 - April 8, 2021

- > 854 outstanding initial and triennial assessments
- ➤ 113 assessments were completed.

#### Assessment Update

- February 26, 2021 April 8, 2021 Cont.
  - > February 26 Special Education Assessment MOU
    - Volunteer Provision
    - 20% Completion Rate Monitoring
      - 113/854 = 13%
    - Contracting with non-public agencies to provide inperson assessments.
  - ➤ March 20, 2021 Safely Re-opening MOU
  - Engaged in the Negotiations Process

# Special Education Assessment <u>Revised</u> MOU

- The District and SCTA entered into an addendum dated April 12, 2021 rendering the February 26, 2021 Special Education Assessment MOU null and void.
  - "SCTA members will conduct standardized and informal special education assessments in accordance with the health and safety measures as outlined in the Safely Reopening Schools to In-Person Instruction/Services MOU of March 20, 2021 and consistent with their regular job duties."
  - Authorizing, as needed, additional hours outside of the employee's workday to complete all special education assessments from the 2019-2020 and 2020-2021 school years.
  - Providing various safety measures, including safety supplies and materials.

#### Assessment Update

- **4.12.2021 6.17.2021** 
  - > Initial Assessments
    - 305 overdue initial assessments
    - 31 initial assessments will become overdue in the next 30 days.
  - > Triennial Assessments
    - 518 overdue triennial assessments
    - 485 triennial assessments will become due between
       4/15/21 and 6/17/2021.

#### Assessment Data Management

- Special Education Information System (SEIS)
  - Local data management system
  - Data is uploaded directly to CALPADS
  - ➤ Data entry occurs by all special education service providers and case managers.
    - More users = great margin for error.
  - ➤ Ongoing SEIS Technical Support
    - District & Site Collaboration
    - Weekly Error Reports and Follow Up

- ❖ S-0297-20/21
  - > Eight (8) Corrective Actions
  - Provide weekly progress updates to CDE
- \$ S-0401-20/21
  - > Seven (7) Corrective Actions
- ❖ April 8, 2021 CDE Update
  - District is out of compliance
  - ➤ A progress update on all corrective actions is provided on the following slides.



## S-0297-20/21

#### 1. Student One Assessments- IN PROGRESS

- a. District shall provide evidence regarding completed student assessments
  - i. Student has disenrolled from SCUSD.
  - ii. District staff are working to legally obtain assessment reports, completed IEP, and compensatory service plan (if applicable).
- 2. Report to Board of Education- COMPLETED & Awaiting CDE Review
- 3. Design and Deliver a Training- IN PROGRESS
  - a. A recorded training was delivered to all required participants on March 18, 2021.
  - b. District staff written verification of attendance is being continuously provided as more participants complete the training.

#### S-0297-20/21 Cont.

# 4. List of Overdue Initial or Triennial Assessments- IN PROGRESS

- **a.** The list shall include the current progress on the students' assessments and the date in which an IEP meeting will be held to review the assessment data.
- b. Overdue from March to November 20, 2020
- C. Weekly lists are being updated and provided to CDE to show the District's progress in these areas.
- 5. Plan ensuring all overdue assessments will be completed by July 30, 2021- IN PROGRESS
  - a. The plan has been responsive to District's negotiations process.
  - **b.** A revised plan was submitted on Friday, April 16th in alignment with the District's current agreement with SCTA to conduct assessments and consists of four phases.

#### S-0297-20/21 Cont.

Plan ensuring all overdue assessments will be completed by July 30, 2021- IN PROGRESS

- Phase 1 & Phase 2
  - Challenges anticipate progress completion.
- Phase 3
  - Based on current outstanding assessments & using the psychoeducational evaluation as a baseline for length of time to complete an assessment--the District anticipates completing 70 assessments per week or 634 assessments by June 17, 2021.
  - This # falls short by approximately 700 assessments.
- Phase 4
  - SCUSD has requested to meet with SCTA to reach an agreement in regards to SCTA members conducting special education assessments over the summer and contract with non-public agencies.

## S-0297-20/21 Cont.

- 6. Parent Communication- COMPLETED & Awaiting CDE Review
  - a. Letters translated into five (5) languages and were sent to families on March 12, 2021
- 7. Weekly Spreadsheets or Weekly Reports- IN PROGRESS
  - a. Nine weekly updates have been provided showing the District's progress in completing initial and triennial assessments from March to November 20, 2020
  - b. Alignment with corrective action #5
- 8. Determine Compensatory Services- IN PROGRESS
  - a. The District is working to develop an appropriate process for determining compensatory services vs. learning loss related to the pandemic.

## S-0401-20/21

- 1. Student One Assessments- IN PROGRESS
  - a. District shall provide evidence regarding completed student assessments
- 2. Report to Board of Education- COMPLETED & Awaiting CDE Review
- 3. Design and Deliver a Training- COMPLETED & Awaiting CDE Review
  - a. A recorded training was delivered to all required participants on March 18, 2021.
  - **b.** District staff written verification of attendance has been submitted.
- Plan ensuring all overdue assessments will be completed by May
   1, 2021- IN PROGRESS
  - a. The plan will align with the plan for S-0297-20/21 as it is inclusive of all students and outstanding assessments.

## S-0401-20/21
