Recommendation: Board to receive an update on the design and construction of a new Pacific Elementary School.

Background/Rationale: As part of on-going projects using data from the 2021 Facilities Master Plan, Pacific Elementary was identified as a project using the equity and facility condition indexes in need for replacement or modernization. Using factors such as interim housing opportunities, condition of current facility to modernize, and state regulations relating to replacement costs of existing schools, staff determined Pacific Elementary School needs to be replaced. The design began in June 2023 and construction is estimated to being in September 2025. It is anticipated that the new school will welcome back students and staff in Fall 2027.

Financial Considerations: The project has a budget of \$97 million using Measure H funds.
