

At-Home COVID-19 Testing

Students and staff might be exposed to COVID-19.

Testing at home helps prevent the spread of COVID-19 and keep schools open

Step 1: Get the following materials:

- iHealth COVID-19 Antigen Rapid Tests (with instructions).
- A device with internet access for submitting your results at the link provided by your school. (If you do not have a device or internet, call Primary at (650) 275-5419.)

Step 2: Test your student (or yourself if you are a staff member):

- **Test # 1:** Use on Monday, before returning from the three-day weekend.
- **Test #2:** If you test positive on Test #1, use Test #2 five days after your positive test result. If Test #2 is negative and your student/you are symptom-free, your student/you may return on Day 6.
If you test negative on Test #1, use Test #2 if your student/you develop symptoms at a later date.

Step 3: Share your test results on Primary.Health (DO NOT use the iHealth app):

- If not already registered, go to Primary Health at <https://my.primary.health/l/scusd-edu> or use the QR code.
- Report your results at the link sent to you by Primary, or here: <https://primary.health>
- Please report all results: negative, positive or inconclusive.

Step 4: Understand your test results:

POSITIVE TEST? **Stay home.** Contact your doctor and your school **right away** for further guidance.

NEGATIVE TEST?

- If your student feels well and has no COVID-19 symptoms, and no recent exposure to someone with COVID-19, RETURN TO SCHOOL!
- If your student is negative but has SYMPTOMS - **stay home** and follow the illness and symptoms requirements for returning to school or work: returntogether.scusd.edu/sites/main/files/file-attachments/hs_appx_b.pdf?1635269397
- If your student has been exposed to someone with COVID-19 and is not fully vaccinated - **stay home** and follow the quarantine guidance here: returntogether.scusd.edu/isolation-quarantine-guidance

UNCLEAR TEST RESULTS? Find a local testing site to retest. Make sure you have a photo of your test.
