#### **PART 1 - GENERAL**

#### 1.01 WORK COVERED BY CONTRACT DOCUMENTS

- A. The requirements of the <u>District's</u> General Conditions, Supplementary Conditions, and Division 1 General Requirements apply to the work of this Section.
